**PUBLIC HEARING** I FWIS COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVthat the LEWIS COUNTY, Washington PLANNING COMMISSION will hold a public hearing on June 28, 2022 at 6:00pm to receive public testimony on the YMCA Rezone Proposal at Mineral Lake.

The YMCA requests an amendment to the Lewis Comprehensive Plan to change the classification of approximately 500 acres north of Mineral Lake from Resource Land to Other Rural Land (nonresource) and to establish a Master Planned Resort (MPR) overlay zone designation, which would allow cabins and campground, along with other recreational facilities. The intended use of the land, if rezoned to MPR, is to establish a youth and family over-night camping facility for 400 campers and 100 staff on the northern and eastern sides of Mineral Lake. Cabins, tent sites, trails and a dock are proposed. The applicant proposes that site development will occur in three construction phases over a 10 to 15 year period.
