Major or Minor Road Standards Deviation Request -- Section 12.60.060 of the Road Standards in the Lewis County Code.

A Minor Design Change Request deals with the construction of facilities, rather than their general design. Some examples are: surfacing materials or thickness thereof, pavement marking layout, exceeding of the maximum road grade, type and/or location of signage, channelization, intersection interior angles and curb radii less than required, field changes during construction, turnaround modifications, utilization of the current Standards in lieu of the road standards in place when the Applicant's proposed project was vested. See the code for a more comprehensive list.

A Major Design Change/Deviation deals with the vertical and horizontal geometrics and safety-related issues. Some examples are: reduced sight distances, vertical or horizontal alignment, geometric design (length, width, bulb radius, etc.), design speed, crossroads, access policy, or restrictive right of way conditions.
