
WHEREAS, said application and all related materials have been reviewed by the BOCC and found appropriate for further proceedings.







## NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC), Lewis County, Washington, has received an application from Public Utility District No. 1 of Thurston County for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, operate and maintain water system facilities on, under and across the following described rights of way:

Jackson Highway in Section 4, Township 12 North, Range 1 West, W.M.

Walsh Lane in Section 27, Township 14 North, Range 3 West, W.M.

Chehalis Valley Drive in Section 3, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, W.M.

Valley Meadows Drive & Valley Meadows Loop in Sections 19 and 30, Township 13 North, Range 1 West, W.M.

Romerman Road in Section 28, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, W.M.

Big Hanaford Road in Section 28, Township 15 North, Range 2 West, W.M.

Jack Fir Ct W, Jack Fir Ct E, Hemlock Ln, Alderwood Dr, Cottonwood Ln and Cannon Rd in Section 1 & 2, Township 13 North, Range 9 East, W.M.


The franchise being considered is for a period of five years.

Said application and all related materials have been reviewed by the BOCC and found appropriate for further proceedings.

A hearing on said non-exclusive franchise will be held on the 23rd day of November, 2015, at or after the hour of 10:00 a.m., in the Commissioners Hearing Room on the 2nd floor of the Historic Courthouse in Chehalis, Washington, when and where all persons may appear and be heard upon the granting of the franchise.

RCW 36.55.040 requires that notice of hearing be posted in three public places in the county seat of the county at least 15 days before the day fixed for hearing, and also published two times in the official newspaper of the county, the last publication to be not less than 5 days before the day fixed for hearing.
