Free Disposal for Debris from December Flood

The Governing Board of the Lewis County Solid Waste Disposal District #1 approved a resolution on Dec. 16, 2015, authorizing free disposal of flood-damaged debris for residents impacted by the December flood event. The free flood debris disposal period began Dec. 16 and will go through Jan. 2, 2016.

Flooded residents must obtain a voucher for free disposal before going to the transfer stations.

Before vouchers are issued, county personnel will inspect the property to verify flood damage. Only materials directly damaged by the flood will be accepted for free disposal. Regular household garbage; tires; televisions; computer monitors, towers and lap tops will not be accepted with a free flood debris voucher.
