Sex Offender Level III Notification

The Lewis County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.50, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public when the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the Sheriff's Office. Further, their previous history places them in a classification level that reflects the potential to re-offend. The individual served the sentence imposed by the court and has properly notified the Sheriff's Office of their current address. The law does not require this offender to do anything other than register. **THEY ARE NOT WANTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AT THIS TIME. Synopsis of Information: In 1999 Wilson was convicted in Lewis County Juvenile Court of Child Molestation 1st Degree, Rape of a Child 1st Degree, and Incest 1st Degree for the sexual assault of a known young female over an extended period of time. At the time of the offenses Wilson was between the ages of 12 and 15. As a result of the conviction he was sentenced to 140 weeks of confinement with the Juvenile Rehabilitation Administration. He was originally released from confinement on 09/19/01. Since that time Wilson has been involved in non-sexual criminal offenses, which include acts of violence failure to register as

a sex offender. He was last released from custody on 08/03/09. Wilson is on Department of Corrections supervision related to his last conviction. Based on the type of crimes committed and his continued criminal behavior, Wilson has been classified as a clear risk to re-offend.

Using this public information to threaten, intimidate or harass sex offenders will not be tolerated by the law enforcement agencies of Lewis County. This abuse could potentially terminate our ability to release this important information to the public.
