

Logistics Section Chief Position Specific Training Oct. 26 - 29, 2010

The (E-967) All-Hazards Logistics Section Chief Course is an ICS Position Specific Course developed by the US Fire Administration in cooperation with the National Wildfire Coordinating Group under the All Hazards IMT Program.

Upon completion of this course the trainee will be provided the opportunity to demonstrate through a major exercise simulation, the knowledge and skills necessary to perform the duties and responsibilities of the Logistics Section Chief in the Incident Command System (ICS).



Who should take this course:

- Individuals who are members of an established Incident Management Team (IMT), who are currently, or likely to assume the role of Logistics Section Chief or Deputy Logistics Section Chief on an Incident Management Team;
- Emergency Management officials, Fire Service and Law Enforcement officers, who may be designated as Logistics Section Chief on their local or state All Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT)
- Prerequisites: IS 300, IS 400 and Command and General Staff Course.
