INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF)
CENTRALIA AND COUNTY FOR ASSISTANCE IN) RESOLUTION 98-133
PROCESSING PENDING SUBDIVISION PLATS)

WHEREAS, preliminary plat applications submitted to Lewis County [County] were pending review at the time of annexation of properties to the City of Centralia [City], in and about the vicinity of the Port of Centralia; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 58.17.033, preliminary plat subdivision applications must be processed under regulations of the municipal corporation in which the application was filed, regardless of subsequent annexation by another municipal corporation or change of boundaries of adjoining municipal corporations; and

WHEREAS, the County planning staff possess knowledge and experience in the application of County regulations, timelines and policies which are superior to that of City staff and review officials; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act of Ch. 39.34 RCW declares that public agencies and governments should seek efficiency in governance through the sharing of resources and personnel for the public benefit; and

WHEREAS, the assistance of County staff, acting for and in the name of the City and subject to reimbursement of their costs by the City, in processing pending subdivision preliminary plat applications in areas recently annexed by the City, is an efficient and effective sharing of government resources, and in the public interest;
NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED that Community Development Director is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement with the City in substantially the form attached hereto, to become effective upon the mutual execution of all parties thereto.
