**ESTABLISHMENT OF GROSS TONNAGE )  
LIMITS ON FERRIER BRIDGE NO. 93 AND ) RESOLUTION #11- 175  
DAVISON BRIDGE NO. 1 LEWIS COUNTY, )  
WASHINGTON )**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Highway Administration has mandated that load rating calculations be performed for all bridges on the National Bridge Inventory; and

**WHEREAS**, load rating calculations for Ferrier Bridge No. 93 and Davison Bridge No. 1 were completed and indicate that legal loads exceed the load rating for some vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Engineer has reviewed these reports and other facts pertinent to the structures, and recommends posting to limit gross tonnage on the bridges.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** pursuant to authority of RCW 46.61.450;

SECTION 1. That the Ferrier Bridge No. 93 on Ferrier Road Milepost 3.49 in Section 08, Township 11 North, Range 2 West, W.M., in Lewis County will be closed to travel by all vehicles having a gross tonnage in excess of those specified below, for a period beginning June 6, 2011 and ending December 31, 2035.

- 22 Tons Gross per Type 3 (2 axle groups)
- 26 Tons Gross per Type 3S-2 (3 axle groups)
- 28 Tons Gross per Type 3-3 (4 axle groups)

SECTION 2. That the Davison Bridge No. 1 on Davison Road Milepost 0.01 in Section 33, Township 13 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in Lewis County will be closed to travel by all vehicles having a gross tonnage in excess of those specified below, for a period beginning June 6, 2011 and ending December 31, 2035.

- 34 Tons Gross per Type 3S-2 (3-axle groups)
- 37 Tons Gross per Type 3-3 (4 axle groups)


SECTION 3. The County Engineer is hereby directed to erect and maintain all necessary signs on or near said bridge pursuant to R.C.W. 46.61.450 and at such other locations as necessary to provide adequate advance notice of such restrictions, and upon erection of such signs, the provisions of this Resolution shall become effective and shall remain in full force for the period of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. Ordinance 1157 makes violation of the above provision(s) a traffic infraction, punishable by monetary penalty not to exceed Two-Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of County Commissioners, Lewis County, Washington, approved a change in load capacity of the Ferrier Bridge No. 93 on Ferrier Road Milepost 3.49 in Section 08, Township 11 North, Range 2 West, W.M., in Lewis County and Davison Bridge No. 1 on Davison Road Milepost 0.01 in Section 33, Township 13 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in Lewis County due to deteriorating conditions. Ferrier and Davison Bridges will be closed to travel by all vehicles having a gross tonnage in excess of those specified below.

22 Tons Gross per Type 3 (2 axle groups)  
26 Tons Gross per Type 3S-2 (3 axle groups)  
28 Tons Gross per Type 3-3 (4 axle groups)


### DAVISON BRIDGE NO. 1

34 Tons Gross per Type 3S-2 (3-axle groups)  
37 Tons Gross per Type 3-3 (4 axle groups)

Pursuant to RCW 46.61.450, the County Engineer will erect and maintain all necessary signs on or near said bridges and at such other locations as necessary to provide adequate advance notice of such restrictions, and upon erection of such signs, the enforcement of these load limits shall become effective and shall remain in full force for the period beginning June 6, 2011 and ending December 31, 2035.

Ordinance 1157 makes violation of the above provision(s) a traffic infraction, punishable by monetary penalty not to exceed Two-Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).
