



FISH HATCHERIES

Data Source

Fish hatcheries were identified by using the County's "points of interest" shapefile. There are three hatcheries listed: the Cowlitz River Trout Hatchery, the Cowlitz River Salmon Hatchery, and the Mossyrock Trout Hatchery.

Locations

Two of the hatcheries are located on the Cowlitz River, one is located at the northeast end of Mayfield Lake.

Zoning

All three of the hatcheries are located in the RDD zone.

Land Use (per County Assessor)

Two of the hatcheries are classified as agriculture, one is classified as utility.

Soils

Two of the hatcheries are located in prime farmland, one is located in prime farmland if protected from flooding.

Size

The parcels range in size from 12 acres to 86 acres.

2007 ARL Zone

None of the hatcheries are located in or immediately adjacent to the 2007 ARL zone.
