

Sex Offender Level III Notification

The Lewis County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.50, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public when the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the Sheriff's Office. Further, their previous history places them in a classification level that reflects the potential to re-offend. The individual served the sentence imposed by the court and has properly notified the Sheriff's Office of their current address. The law does not require this offender to do anything other than register. **THEY ARE NOT WANTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AT THIS TIME. Synopsis of Information: In 1990, White was convicted in Lewis County Superior Court of two counts of Rape of a Child 1st Degree and one count of Rape of a Child 2nd Degree. The crimes involved the sexual assault of young boys who were known to White and took place over an extended period of time. As a result of his conviction, he was sentenced to 194 months in prison. He was released from confinement on 12/17/06. White did participate in sex offender treatment while he was in prison. During treatment he disclosed numerous other victims, which did not result in new criminal charges. Based on the type of crimes committed and White's extensive non-adjudicated

sex offender history, he has been classified as a high risk to re-offend.

Using this public information to threaten, intimidate or harass sex offenders will not be tolerated by the law enforcement agencies of Lewis County. This abuse could potentially terminate our ability to release this important information to the public.
