WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolutions 11-112 and 10-262, the Board of County Commissioners approved the funding agreement with the State Public Works Board and State Department of Commerce for improvements to the City of Vader water system; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works was approved to administer the grants and manage the project;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 12-045, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the 2012 Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction and this project shall be performed by contract in accordance with these specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is instructed to issue a Call for Bids and Contract Specifications for the VADER-ENCHANTED VALLEY WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS. Bids for this project shall be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532) by or before 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 10, 2012 and will be opened on or after 11:30 a.m. on May 10, 2012, subject to official project addenda that establishes an alternate bid due date or opening time.



CALL FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis County or designee, will open sealed bids and publicly read them aloud on or after 11:30 A.M. on Thursday, May 10, 2012, at the Lewis County Courthouse, Chehalis, Washington, for the Vader-Enchanted Valley Water System Improvement Project in Lewis County.

SEALED BIDS MUST BE DELIVERED BEFORE 11:00 A.M.

(Lewis County official time is displayed on Axxess Intertel phones in the office of Board of County Commissioners. **Bids submitted after 11:00 AM will not be considered for this project.**))

Sealed bids must be delivered to the Lewis County Commissioners Office (351 N.W. North Street, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532) by **11:00 A.M.** on the date specified for opening, and in an envelope clearly marked: ***"SEALED BID FOR THE VADER-ENCHANTED VALLEY WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, TO BE OPENED ON OR AFTER 11:30 A.M. ON THURSDAY, MAY 10, 2012."***

Each bid shall be in accordance with the specifications and other contract documents now on file with the County Engineer. The contract documents may be viewed and downloaded from Lewis County's Web Site @ www.lewiscountywa.gov or you may call the Lewis County Engineers office @ (360) 740-2612 and request a copy be mailed to you for a fee.


Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the Treasurer of Lewis County in the sum of five percent (5%) of the bid to be forfeited to Lewis County by the successful bidder in case they fail to enter into contract and file an acceptable surety bond in the full amount of the bid to fill conditions of said contract within twenty (20) calendar days of the date of award.

This project is funded through the Washington State Community Development Block Grant program with federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and through the Washington State Drinking Water State Revolving Fund program with federal funds from the Environmental Protection Agency.

The following is applicable to Federal-Aid projects. The Lewis County Public Works Department in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities in the bidding.
