- Ordinance 1243: Repealing LCC Chapter 16.02.040(8) in its entirety, and substitute new language for Boundary Line Adjustment - Changes are being proposed that will address Lewis County Public Health and Social Services concern related to their review of boundary line adjustments.

The public hearings will be at the Lewis County Courthouse, Commissioners' Hearing Room, 351 NW North Street, Chehalis, WA 98532. Public written and oral comments may be presented to the Board of County Commissioners during the public testimony portion of the hearings on the proposed amendments. Anyone interested in testifying should attend.
