WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 13-542, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the 2014-2019 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, Lewis County's Hwy 603 Stabilization Project, CRP 2144 is listed as Project #13 on the 2014-2019 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet funding deadlines, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to stockpile culvert and storm sewer pipe prior to the Hwy 603 project which will stabilize 1.72 miles of Hwy 603 in Lewis County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution, the Board of County Commissioners will adopt the 2014 Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction on March 31, 2014 and this project shall be performed by contract in accordance with these specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is instructed to issue a Call for Bids and Contract Specifications for the Material Purchase of Culvert and Storm Sewer Pipe for the Hwy 603 Stabilization project, CRP 2144. Bids for this project shall be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532) by or before 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 15, 2014 and will be opened on or after 11:30 a.m. on April 15, 2014, subject to official project addenda that establishes an alternate bid due date or opening time.



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis County or designee, will open sealed bids and publicly read them aloud on or after 11:30 a.m. on April 15, 2014, at the Lewis County Courthouse, Chehalis, Washington, for the Material Purchase of Culvert and Storm Sewer Pipe for the Hwy 603 Stabilization project, CRP 2144.

SEALED BIDS MUST BE DELIVERED BY OR BEFORE 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 15, 2014

(Lewis County official time is displayed on Axxess Intertel phones in the office of the Board of County Commissioners. **Bids submitted after 11:00 a.m. will not be considered for this project.**)

Sealed bids must be delivered to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532), by or before **11:00 a.m.** on the date specified for opening, and in an envelope clearly marked: **"SEALED BID FOR THE MATERIAL PURCHASE OF CULVERT AND STORM SEWER PIPE FOR THE HWY 603 STABILIZATION PROJECT, CRP 2144, TO BE OPENED ON OR AFTER 11:30 A.M. ON APRIL 15, 2014."**


Each bid shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and other contract documents now on file with the County Engineer. The contract documents may be viewed and downloaded from Lewis County's website @ www.lewiscountywa.gov or you may call the Lewis County Engineer's Office @ (360) 740-2612 or email Kim.Amrine@lewiscountywa.gov and request a copy be mailed to you.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the Treasurer of Lewis County in the sum of five percent (5%) of the bid to be forfeited to Lewis County by the successful bidder in case they fail to enter into contract and file an acceptable surety bond in the full amount of the bid to fill conditions of said contract within twenty (20) calendar days of the date of award.

The Lewis County Public Works Department in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities in the bidding.
