WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 14-105, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the amended 2014-2019 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, Lewis County's Leudinghaus Bridge No. 87 (Mays Bridge) Project, CRP 2123, FEMA P.W. 110 is listed as Project #8 on the amended 2014-2019 Six-Year TIP; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to replace Leudinghaus Bridge No. 87, which was destroyed during the 2007 flood, with a new structure approximately 2500 feet upstream, and this bridge replacement requires constructing a new access road between SR 6 and Leudinghaus Road, relocating the terminus of Hatchery Road, and improving approximately 1150 feet of Leudinghaus Road. These improvements will include constructing a 200 foot steel through-truss bridge, structural earth walls, clearing and grubbing, excavation, asphalt concrete pavement, installing beam guardrail, installing a three sided culvert, placing rip rap, constructing storm water facilities, and other work as directed by the Engineer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 14-111, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the 2014 Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction and this project shall be performed by contract in accordance with these specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is instructed to issue a Call for Bids and Contract Specifications for the Leudinghaus Bridge No. 87 (Mays Bridge) Project, CRP 2123, FEMA P.W. 110. Bids for this project shall be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532) by or before 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 6, 2014 and will be opened on or after 11:30 a.m. on May 6, 2014, subject to official project addenda that establishes an alternate bid due date or opening time.







NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis County or designee, will open sealed bids and publicly read them aloud on or after 11:30 a.m. on May 6, 2014, at the Lewis County Courthouse, Chehalis, Washington, for the Leudinghaus Bridge No. 87 (Mays Bridge) Project, CRP 2123, FEMA P.W. 110.

Sealed proposals must be delivered to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532), by or before **11:00 A.M.** on the date specified for opening, and in an envelope clearly marked: **"SEALED BID FOR THE LEUDINGHAUS BRIDGE NO. 87 (MAYS BRIDGE) PROJECT, CRP 2123, FEMA P.W. 110, TO BE OPENED ON OR AFTER 11:30 A.M. ON MAY 6, 2014.**


All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Lewis County Public Works Department.

Informational copies of maps, plans and specifications are on file for inspection in the office of the County Engineer of Lewis County in Chehalis, Washington. All Contractor questions and Lewis County clarifying answers will be posted on our website and emailed to all Contractors registered on Lewis County's Planholder List. Plan or specification changes shall be accomplished through official project addendums.
