Sex Offender Level III Notification

The Lewis County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.50, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public when the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the Sheriff's Office. Further, their previous history places them in a classification level that reflects the potential to re-offend. The individual served the sentence imposed by the court and has properly notified the Sheriff's Office of their current address. The law does not require this offender to do anything other than register. **THEY ARE NOT WANTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AT THIS TIME. Synopsis of Information: In 2004 Wolverton pled guilty in Lewis County Juvenile Court to the crimes of Child Molestation 1st Degree and Communication with a Minor for Immoral Purposes. The offenses involved Wolverton having sexual contact with two young children that were not related to him when he was 12 years old. He was originally released from custody on 08/05/06. Following his initial release he was convicted in 2007 of Communication with a Minor for Immoral Purposes in King County Juvenile Court. This crime involved sexual contact with a young child that was related to him when he was 14 years old. He was last released from confinement on 09/19/08. Based on the totality of the circumstances, Wolverton has been identified as a clear risk to the

community and this notification is required.

Using this public information to threaten, intimidate or harass sex offenders will not be tolerated by the law enforcement agencies of Lewis County. This abuse could potentially terminate our ability to release this important information to the public.
