**RESOLUTION NO. 15 102**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 47.48.010 gives authority to the county legislative authority to close roads for a period of time; and

**WHEREAS**, water on, over, and along the portion of unmaintained county road approximately 0.6 miles west of the end of the maintained Bunker Road poses a potential hazard to vehicular traffic, and the County also received a letter from the State of Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife in 2005 stating that conditions were creating habitat degradation and loss of fish life; and

**WHEREAS**, said letter stated that the site is also a violation of the Washington State Hydraulic Code and unless corrected, legal action would occur; and

**WHEREAS**, for the reasons cited above, Resolution 10-092 was passed by the Board of County Commissioners on April 5, 2010, which closed said portion of unmaintained road to all vehicles during the period of high water October 15 through April 15, each year through 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, road conditions have not changed and it appears to be in the best public interest to extend the closure.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that, pursuant to R.C.W. 47.48.010 and .020, effective April 15, 2015, for the period October 15 to April 15 each year through 2020, said unmaintained county road in Section 19, Township 14 North, Range 4 West, W.M., shall be closed to all vehicles from the end of Bunker Road, westerly through the area of water on, over, and along the road, to a point east of the intersecting private road running north, a total distance of approximately 3600 feet (0.68 mile).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that to effectuate the provisions of this resolution, the County Engineer shall direct that the gate at the present end of Bunker Road remain locked

at all times during the period October 15 to April 15 each year, and shall close by such means as he shall determine appropriate, the west end of the closure, and further, shall give notice thereof by posting signs on each end of the closure as will give adequate notice to traffic.





**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of County Commissioners, Lewis County, Washington, approved the extended closure of Bunker Road to all through traffic as water on, over, and along the unmaintained portion of Bunker Road approximately 0.6 mile west of the maintained Bunker Road poses a potential hazard to vehicular traffic, and the County received a letter from the State of Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife in 2005 stating that conditions were creating habitat degradation and loss of fish life. The road conditions have not changed and it appears to be in the best public interest to extent the closure of Bunker Road. Pursuant to R.C.W. 47.48.010 and .020, effective April 15, 2015, to April 15, 2020, for the period of October 15 to April 15, said unmaintained county road in Section 19, Township 14 North, Range 4 West, W.M., shall be closed to all vehicles from the end of Bunker Road, westerly through the area of water on, over, and along the road, to a point east of the intersecting private road running north, a total distance of approximately 3600 feet (0.68 mile). To effectuate the provisions of this resolution, the County Engineer shall direct that the gate at the present end of Bunker Road remain locked seasonally at all times during the period October 15 to April 15.


