WHEREAS, Resolution 14-332, passed by the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on December 15, 2014, directed the County Engineer to examine a portion of Mountain View Drive, Packwood, and report his opinion to the BOCC; and

WHEREAS, as required by RCW 36.87, on the 22th day of April, 2015, the Report of the County Engineer on the matter of the proposed vacation of the following described portion of Mountain View Drive, Packwood was filed in the office of the BOCC, to wit:

All that part of Mountain View Drive dedicated to the public in the Plat of Eighth High Valley Park, recorded in Volume 5 of Plats, Pages 67-69, records of Lewis County, lying West of Cowlitz View Drive and East of Cannon Road, in Section 1, Township 13 North, and Range 9 East W.M.

WHEREAS, the report and all related materials having been reviewed by the Board and found appropriate for further proceedings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the 1st day of June, 2014 at or after the hour of 10:00 a.m., in the BOCC Hearing Room on the 2nd floor of the Historical Courthouse in Chehalis, Washington, has been fixed by the BOCC as the time and place for the hearing on the Engineer's Report, when and where all persons may appear and be heard upon the report and upon the matter of the vacation of the roads.





Area outlined in red requested for vacation. See next page for closer detail




Section 1, Township 13 North, Range 9 East, W.M.

Canyon Rd


NOTICE OF HEARING
