WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 15-129, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the Amended 2015-2020 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, Lewis County's Davis Creek Rd. Turnarounds & US 12 Intersection Improvements Project - FEMA PW 260, CRP 2125 is listed as a priority project on the Amended 2015-2020 Six-Year TIP; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to improve Davis Creek Road intersections with US Highway 12 and construction of new turnarounds by clearing and grubbing, excavation, asphalt concrete pavement, placing riprap, installation of a culvert, permanent seeding, and other work as directed by the Engineer; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 14-111, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the 2014 Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction and this project shall be performed by contract in accordance with these specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is instructed to issue a Call for Bids and Contract Specifications for the Davis Creek Rd. Turnarounds & US 12 Intersection Improvements Project - FEMA PW 260, CRP 2125. Bids for this project shall be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532) by or before 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 and will be opened on or after 11:30 a.m. on August 11, 2015, subject to official project addenda that establishes an alternate bid due date or opening time.





NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis County or designee, will open sealed bids and publicly read them aloud on or after 11:30 a.m. on August 11, 2015, at the Lewis County Courthouse, Chehalis, Washington, for the Davis Creek Rd. Turnarounds & US 12 Intersection Improvements Project - FEMA PW 260, CRP 2125.

Sealed proposals must be delivered to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532), by or before **11:00 A.M.** on the date specified for opening, and in an envelope clearly marked: **"SEALED BID FOR THE DAVIS CREEK RD. TURNAROUNDS & US 12 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT - FEMA PW 260, CRP 2125 TO BE OPENED ON OR AFTER 11:30 A.M. ON AUGUST 11, 2015"**.


All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Lewis County Public Works Department.
