WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Division of Lewis County Public Works collects large woody debris, at the Centralia Transfer Station, throughout the year which needs to be disposed of by chipping and grinding at least twice a year; and

WHEREAS, during weather events Lewis County's Road Crews collect large amounts of woody debris which needs to be disposed of by chipping and grinding on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) wishes to improve various sites in Lewis County by grinding and or chipping woody debris and loading it into Contracting Agency supplied hauling vehicles, and other work as directed by the Engineer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is instructed to issue a Call for Bids and Contract Specifications for the 2015-2016 Debris Removal Project. Bids for this project shall be submitted to the Clerk of the BOCC (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532) in accordance with the bid call or project addenda.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) of Lewis County or designee, will open sealed bids and publicly read them aloud on or after 11:30 a.m. on August 18, 2015, at the Lewis County Courthouse, Chehalis, Washington, for the 2015-2016 Debris Removal Project.

SEALED BIDS MUST BE DELIVERED BY OR BEFORE 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, August 18, 2015

(Lewis County official time is displayed on Axxess Intertel phones in the office of the Board of County Commissioners. **Bids submitted after 11:00 AM will not be considered for this project.**)

Sealed proposals must be delivered to the Clerk of the BOCC (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, CMS-01, Chehalis, Washington 98532), by or before **11:00 A.M.** on the date specified for opening, and in an envelope clearly marked: **"SEALED BID FOR THE 2015-2016 DEBRIS REMOVAL PROJECT TO BE OPENED ON OR AFTER 11:30 A.M. ON AUGUST 18, 2015"**.


All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Lewis County Public Works Department.

Informational copies of maps, plans and specifications are on file for inspection in the office of the County Engineer of Lewis County in Chehalis, Washington. Plan or specification changes shall be accomplished through official project addendums.
