**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the LEWIS COUNTY, WASHINGTON, PLANNING COMMISSION will hold a public hearing** on September 22, 2015, starting at or after 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of taking testimony on the Lewis County Countywide Planning Policies. No changes to the existing policies are proposed as part of this Public Hearing. The policies have been reviewed by both the Planned Growth Committee (at a workshop on April 22, 2015) and the Planning Commission (at a workshop on July 14, 2015), and neither group has recommended changes to the document at this time.

The public hearing will be at the Lewis County Courthouse, Commissioners' Hearing Room, 351 NW North Street, Chehalis, WA. At the hearing, members of the public will be invited to speak and/or provide written statements regarding the Countywide Planning Policies. All persons wishing to be heard on this matter are encouraged to attend. Written comments may also be submitted in advance of the hearing by mail, email or in person to the contact information below.
