**WHEREAS**, Lewis County accepted the Master Plan update on September 19, 2016 (Resolution No. 16-248); and


**WHEREAS**, Lewis County intends to rehabilitate the taxiway with financial assistance from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and Washington State Department of Transportation (DOT) Aviation Division; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears to be in the best public interest to issue an Invitation for Bids related to the Taxiway Improvement at the Ed Carlson Memorial Field- South Lewis County Airport.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Community Development Department is instructed to issue an Invitation for Bids and Contract Specification for the 2017 Taxiway Rehabilitation Project at the South Lewis County Airport A.I.P. NO 3-53-0078-008-2015. Bids for this project shall be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, Chehalis, Washington 98532) by or before 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, July 11, 2017 and will be opened on or after 11:30am on July 11, 2017.

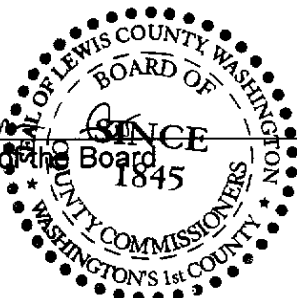



**INVITATION FOR BIDS**  
**2016/2017 Airport Improvements Project**  
**South Lewis County Airport**  
**Toledo, Washington**  
**A.I.P. No. 3-53-0078-008**

Sealed proposals will be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Lewis County Commissioners (351 N.W. North Street, Room 210, Chehalis, Washington 98532) by or before **11:00 A.M.** on **Tuesday, July 11, 2017** and will be opened on or after 11:30am on July 11, 2017.

The work contemplated consists of, but is not limited to, the following:

1. Pavement Removal of existing taxiway for approximately 4,500 linear ft.
2. Crack Sealing/Fog Seal of main apron
3. New HMAC Pavement for approximately 5,220 linear ft x 25 ft wide taxiways.
4. Drainage Improvements
5. Electrical – Airfield Lighting including new PAPI, REIL's, Guidance Signs, and Taxiway Edge Lighting.
6. Paint Marking of new taxiways and remarking of existing runway.

The contract time will be limited to 100 calendar days to substantially complete all work. Liquidated damages will be charged as described in the General Provisions should the contractor fail to complete the work within the time limit specified. Sundays and legal holidays shall be excluded in determining days in default.

The County will not sell bid packages. Free-of-charge access to project bid documents (plans, specifications, addenda, and Bidders List) is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to [www.bxwa.com](http://www.bxwa.com) and clicking on "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "Lewis County". This online plan room provides Bidders with fully usable online documents with the ability to: download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free online digitizer/take-off tool. It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project. Contact Builders Exchange of Washington at (425) 258-1303 should you require assistance with access or registration. Informational copies of any available maps, plans, and specifications are on file for inspection at the Airport - 5235 Jackson Highway, Toledo, Washington 98591.

An **OPTIONAL** pre-bid conference will be held on Thursday, June 29, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. All interested bidders are **ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND**. This conference will be held at the Airport Terminal Building, 5235 Jackson Highway, Toledo, Washington 98591.

The proposed contract is subject to the following regulations:

1. Bidders must submit qualification statements in accordance with the terms of Subsection 20-02 of the General Provisions with their Proposal.
2. The proposed contract is under and subject to Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1986 and to the Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) and Federal Labor Provisions.
3. All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates established the U.S. Secretary of Labor or the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries, whichever is higher.
4. Each Bidder must supply all information required by the bid documents and specifications.
5. The EEO requirements, labor provisions, and wage rates are included in the specifications and bid documents.

6. Each Bidder must complete, sign and furnish with his bid a "Certification of Nonsegregated Facilities" and a statement entitled "Bidders Statement of Previous Contracts Subject to EEO Clause," as contained in the Bid Proposal.
7. A Contractor having 50 or more employees and his subcontractors having 50 or more employees and who may be awarded a subcontract of \$50,000 or more will be required to maintain an affirmative action program, the standards for which are contained in the specifications.
8. To be eligible for award each Bidder must comply with the affirmative action requirements which are contained in the specifications.
9. Disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award of any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement.
10. Women will be afforded equal opportunity in all areas of employment. However, the employment of women shall not diminish the standards or requirements for the employment of minorities.
11. The following federal provisions are incorporated into the contract requirements;
  - a. Buy American Preference
  - b. Foreign Trade Restriction
  - c. Davis Bacon
  - d. Affirmative Action
  - g. Government wide Debarment and Suspension
  - h. Government wide Requirements for a Drug free Workplace

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond on the form bound within the Contract Documents or one similar, payable to Lewis County in an amount not less than 5 percent (5%) of the amount bid. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond, each in the full amount of the contract price.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all proposals not conforming to the intent and purpose of the contract documents. No Bidder may withdraw his proposal within ninety (90) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

All bidders and primary subcontractors are strongly urged to examine the site to become familiar with all site conditions prior to bid, and may examine the site of the proposed work at their own convenience subject to arrangements with the Airport. Bidders shall notify the Airport Manager, (360) 864-4966, prior to any site examination on the airport property.

The award of the contract is subject to approval of the Federal Aviation Administration and availability of federal funding.
