**WHEREAS**, said application and all related materials have been reviewed by the BOCC and found appropriate for further proceedings.



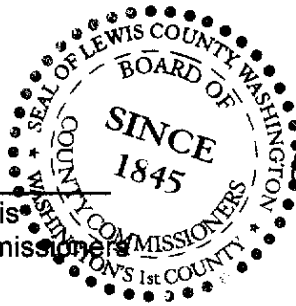

## NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners, Lewis County, Washington (BOCC), has received an application for a non-exclusive franchise from Lake Mayfield Community Club to replace their existing franchise which is scheduled to terminate in June, 2017, to construct, operate and maintain water system facilities on, under and across Clahoua Drive, Chief Umptux Road, Chief Kiona Road, and Wennassee Loop.

The franchise being considered is for a period of five years.

The application and all related materials have been reviewed by the BOCC and found appropriate for further proceedings.

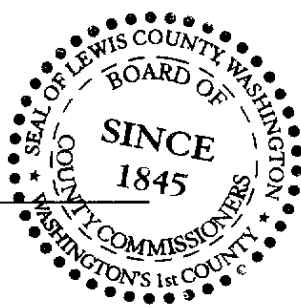
A hearing on the non-exclusive franchise will be held on the 5th day of June, 2017, at or after the hour of 10:00 a.m., in the Commissioners Hearing Room on the 2nd floor of the Historic Courthouse in Chehalis, Washington, when and where all persons may appear and be heard upon the granting of the franchise.

RCW 36.55.040 requires that notice of hearing be posted in three public places in the county seat of the county at least 15 days before the day fixed for hearing, and also published two times in the official newspaper of the county, the last publication to be not less than 5 days before the day fixed for hearing.
