WHEREAS, the Preliminary Design Report prepared by Murray, Smith, and Associates has presented an Engineer's Estimate of Probable Cost which exceeds the maximum grant award amount; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that additional funding in the form of a United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development (USDA RD) Loan/Grant will be necessary to complete the project, and;

WHEREAS, the USDA RD Loan/Grant program requires Public Notice of Intent to Apply prior to submission of the loan application,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners approves the Notice to the public and the Clerk of the Board is hereby instructed to proceed with all necessary notifications, posting and publication.
