WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to repair damage to the Interstate 5 (I-5) overpass of Koontz Road; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to close Koontz Road approximately 100 feet on each side of the overpass to all through traffic during the period of such project work; and

WHEREAS, Koontz Road will remain open for local access up to, but not beyond, the point of closure, and alternate routes will be available to access residences and businesses beyond the closure.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to RCW 47.48.010 and .020, beginning September 18, 2023, and ending before December 31, 2023, Koontz Road beginning at 100 feet east of the overpass to 100 feet west of the overpass shall be closed to all through traffic.


