EXHIBIT "A-1"

PRIVATE ROAD ADDRESSING PROGRAM

This program is designed to provide addresses to residents on private roads, and to aid emergency services and others in locating residences. Multiple residents who are served by private roads and/or driveways desiring separate addresses are encouraged to participate i'n this program.

NOTE: Use of this program will result in your permanent address being changed.

Prior to address assignment, over 50% of the property owners served by the private road will have to sign the attached Exhibit "B-1" acknowledging the conditions attached hereto which state; that the address is for <u>location purposes only</u>, that the status of the private road will not be changed, that mail delivery and school bus service still will not be available on the private road, and that Lewis County will not take over road maintenance responsibilities. The approval of the private road name and address assignment does not certify nor guarantee the private road as adequate access to the lots it serves.

Together with the executed Exhibit "B-1" a designated contact person shall provide Lewis County a copy of a map showing the following information:

- 1. North Arrow
- 2. A minimum of two (2) of the nearest cross roads. Please label all road names and any other significant landmarks for locational reference.
- 3. The boundary lines of all properties served by the proposed private road.
- 4. The exact location of the proposed private road on each affected property.
- 5. The location of any fences in close proximity to the proposed private road.
- 6. A copy of the Lewis County Assessor's map showing the road location and properties to be addressed.

Private road names will be reviewed for approval and subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. The proposed road name shall not duplicate any other road name in Lewis County.
- 2. The proposed road name shall not exceed 10 characters or letters, including spaces between letters or characters excluding the words private, road, drive, lane. etc.
- 3. Lewis County reserves the right to veto any proposed name they believe would be either confusing to the public or inappropriate.

After all applicable information has been provided, and the proposed road name has been approved, the Lewis County Community Development Department, Permit Center and Building and Fire Safety Section will assign addresses based on the same system and formula presently used to assign addresses on public roads.

Lewis County Public Works, Traffic Control Division, will only install the necessary road name signs at private roads intersecting county roads and state highways. Sign installation will only take place after the contact person has notified tl1e Permit Center that the address stake identifying the proposed private road is in place. All interior private branch road name signs shall be purchased and installed at the residents' expense, and shall conform to Lewis County road sign standards.

ADDRESSEE'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ASSIGNMENT OF PRIVATE ROAD ADDRESS AND CONDITIONS ATTACHED THERETO

I have read the foregoing Private Road Addressing Program (Exhibit "A") and the conditions under which it is issued. I understand that the assignment of a private road address is made with the following conditions:

- 1. Use of this program will result in your permanent address being changed.
- 2. The US Postal Service will not deliver mail to a residence on a private road.
- 3. School bus service, and all other services associated with county roads will <u>not</u> be available on a private road.
- 4. The assignment of a private road address does <u>not</u> mean that the private road is accepted into the County Road System, and that Lewis County has <u>no</u> responsibility to build, improve, maintain, or otherwise service the private road.
- 5. Permission given for Lewis County to utilize GPS for mapping of the new private road.

PRIVATE ROAD SIGN INSTALLATION

NOTE: These instructions apply only to private road signs that are on county right-of-way. Private road signs on private property need to be handled by the landowner(s). It is important that signs be replaced as soon as possible so that emergency vehicles can find you.

There is an installation fee for installing private road signs for new private roads. This is a one-time fee of \$125.

When a private road sign is down on the ground (no damage), call Public Works at 360-740-1123, and we will put up the sign at no charge.

When the road sign of an existing private road is missing or damaged, it is the responsibility of the residents who live on a private road.

Once the sign is made it can be dropped off or mailed to the Permit Center located in the Lewis County Public Services Building, 2025 NE Kresky Ave.




PRIVATE ROAD SIGN STANDARDS



REQUIREMENTS:

- ROAD NAME SIGN MUST HAVE A RETROREFLECTIVE WHITE BACKGROUND WITH BLACK LETTERING ON BOTH SIDES OF THE SIGN PLATE.
- MIXED-CASE LETTERING CONSISTS OF AN INITIAL UPPER-CASE LETTER FOLLOWED BY LOWER-CASE LETTERS.
- SIGN PLATE MUST BE .080" THICK ALUMINUM FOR SIGNS UP TO 40 INCHES IN LENGTH, AND .125" THICK ALUMINUM FOR SIGNS 40-50 INCHES IN LENGTH.
- MAXIMUM SIGN LENGTH IS 50 INCHES.
- SIGNS NOT ADHERING STRICTLY TO THESE STANDARDS
