Resolution 001-24 – Election of Chair and Vice Chair for the Governing Board of Commissioners of the Lewis County Solid Waste Disposal District No. 1.

Motion by Scott J. Brummer and seconded by Lindsey R. Pollock, DVM. Motion carried.

- VII. Transfer Station Operations Presented by Rocky Lyon, Solid Waste Manager.
 - a. Community Litter Program Report December.
 - The litter program coordinator and crew cleaned up 12 road miles, spent a total of 46.5 hours picking up 1,160 pounds of litter. They also spent 54 hours working on 5 illegal dumpsites, cleaning up 2,960 pounds of litter.
 - The Lewis County contracted litter crew-roadside- spent 16 hours cleaning up 1 illegal dumpsite, picking up 7,780 pounds of litter.
 - Volunteers in Centralia and throughout Lewis County reported spending 130.50 hours collecting 119 bags of litter.
 - b. Transfer Station Tonnage December.
 - The combined monthly tonnage was 6,574.
 - Year to Date the tonnage was 89,599.
- VIII. Financial Reports Presented by Rocky Lyon, Solid Waste Manager.
 - a. Monthly reports December.
 - Fund 4150 revenue per the Munis report was \$266,395 and showed a net operating loss of (\$564,471). The ending fund balance was \$3,985,793.
 - Fund 4010 total expenses \$613,233.
 - Total reserve balances \$863,130.

- XI. Approval of Transfers from Solid Waste Disposal District #1 to Lewis County Solid Waste Utility.

Motion by Scott J. Brummer and seconded by Lindsey R. Pollock, DVM, to approve payments and transfers in the amount of \$830,866 for the month of December. Motion carried.

- XII. Staff Discussion.
 - a. Rocky Lyon, Solid Waste Manager, presented the 2024 rate increase scenarios to the board. The utility is looking to increase its rate to \$120/ton including tax. This increase will ensure it will not need another rate increase through 2026. Bulky waste, yard waste, tires, and refrigerated appliances will also increase to off-set costs. The utility is encouraging the public to seek curbside pickup and recycling as it will alleviate traffic through both facilities. The next step is to receive recommendations from both the Executive Advisory Committee (EAC) and the Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC). If approved, the rate increase will take place on July 1, 2024.

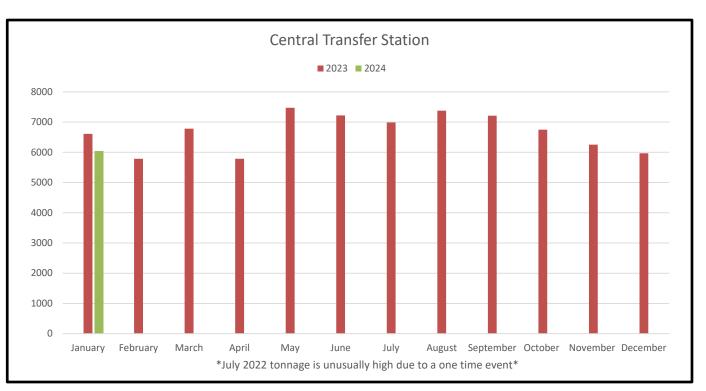

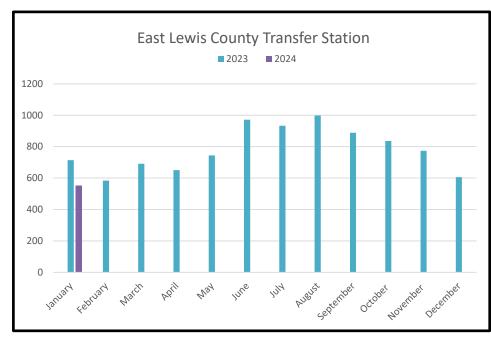

*Breakdown of building/facility rent: Central Transfer Station (CTS) monthly rent is \$51,000 and the East Lewis County Transfer Station (ELCTS) monthly rent is \$1,859. CTS monthly rent payment increased from \$38,700 to \$51,000 in January 2010. \$38,700 goes toward a bond payment and \$12,300 is reserved in Solid Waste Fund 4010 for capital improvements. Per BOCC Resolution #19-292, when the bond is fully paid in December 2024, the entire \$51,000 payment will be accounted for in the Solid Waste capital improvement reserve.
