## **Private Road Naming History**

- Readdressing began in 1970s
- Dashed addressing began in 1990s





## **Current Requirements**

- Land divisions that create 3 or more lots require a private road name
- Road name must be 10 or fewer letters
- Road name cannot duplicate other names in county
- 50% of the property owners on the road must agree




# **Current Requirements**

\*\*Does not apply to simple segregations

\*\*Does not apply to extensions of private roads

\*\*Inconsistently applied to spurs off private roads





#### **Proposed Amendments**

- When 3 or more lots are created through any land division, including simple segs, sites must be addressed
  - To be addressed, there must be a road name
- If a spur off a private road, spur needs a new name
- If an extension of a dashed road, the whole road needs a name
- Road names must meet the county's policies
  - 10 letters total
  - No duplication
