

## Sex Offender Level III Notification

The Lewis County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.50, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public when the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the Sheriff's Office. Further, their previous history places them in a classification level that reflects the potential to re-offend. The individual served the sentence imposed by the court and has properly notified the Sheriff's Office of their current address. The law does not require this offender to do anything other than register. THEY ARE NOT WANTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AT THIS TIME. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC. **Synopsis of Information:** In 2004, 16-year old Liebich was convicted for Indecent Liberties with Forcible Compulsion after luring a known 19-year old female, who was also developmentally delayed. Once alone, Liebich began sexually assaulting the female victim. As a result of the conviction Liebich was sentenced to 104 weeks in custody and completed an Outpatient Sex Offender Treatment Program. Liebich was categorized as a Level III Offender based on an inability to control his compulsion and a history of sexually inappropriate behavior. Because of his Level

**III Offender status Community notification is required.** 

Using this public information to threaten, intimidate or harass sex offenders will not be tolerated by the law enforcement agencies of Lewis County. This abuse could potentially terminate our ability to release this important information to the public.
