EMERGENCY ORDER 2024-03

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2024 the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) notified courts across the State of Washington that a significant disruption had occurred to information systems that are hosted by the AOC due to “unauthorized activity on the Washington Courts network,” which impacts the operations of the Superior Court and Clerk’s Offices across the State of Washington.

WHEREAS, the aforementioned information systems are restored to the extent that court operations may resume without significant disruption.

WHEREAS, the Lewis County Clerk’s Office has worked tirelessly to enter the backlog of documents to the files.

NOW THEREFORE, Emergency Order 2024-01 and Emergency Order 2024-02 and the provisions therein, are terminated. This order shall take effect on November 25, 2024 at 8:00 am.
