THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LABREE ROAD TO
ALL THROUGH TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, RCW 47.48.010 gives authority to the county legislative authority to close roads for a period of time; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Lewis County to complete a culvert replacement project on Labree Road at MP 0.459; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to close Labree Road at MP 0.459 to all through traffic during the period of such work; and

WHEREAS, Labree Road will remain open for local access from either end up to but not beyond the point of closure at MP 0.459, and other county roads are available for detour.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to RCW 47.48.010 and .020, beginning July 1, 2025, and ending October 30, 2025, Labree Road at MP 0.459 in Section 9, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, W.M., shall be closed to all through traffic.

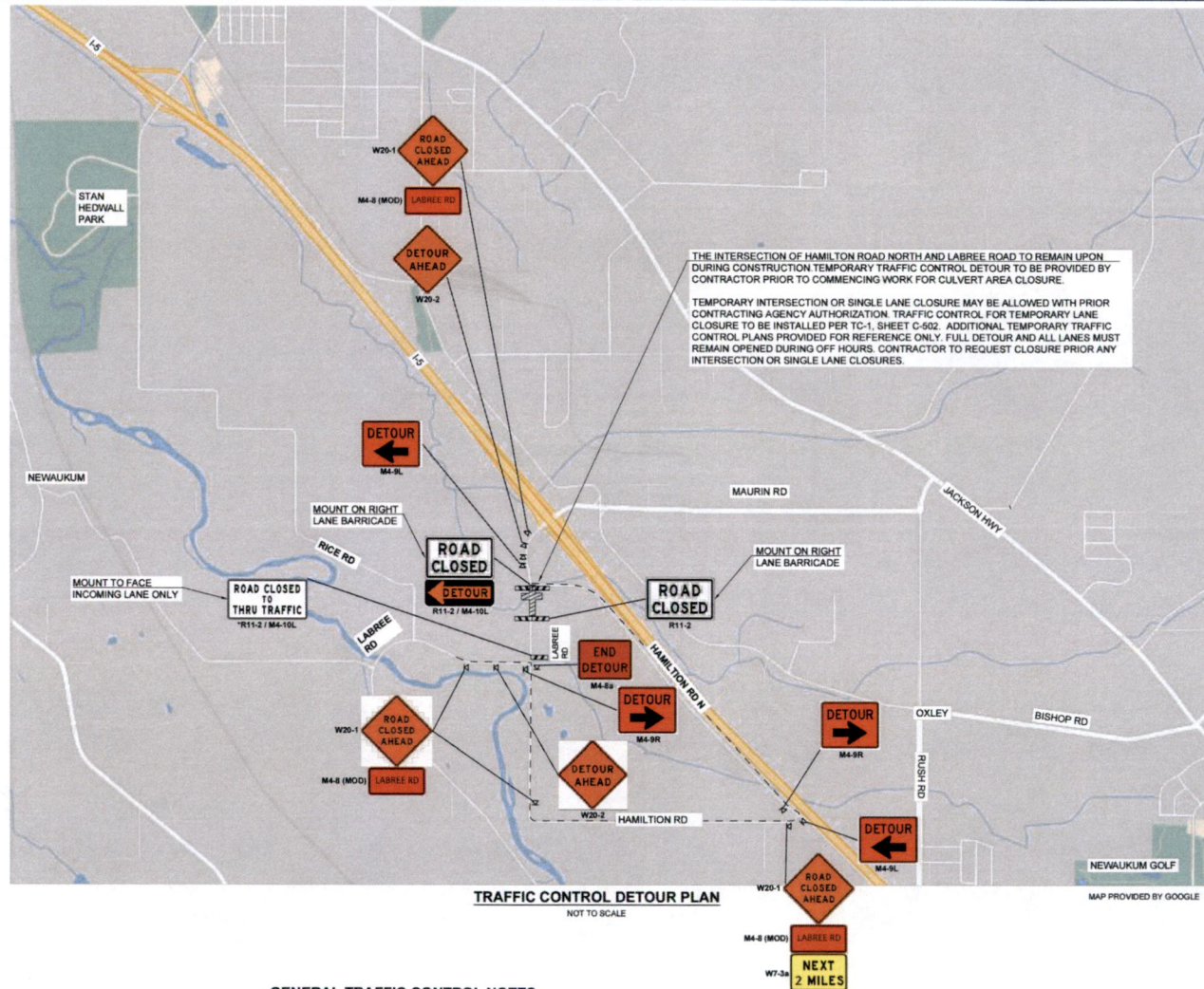

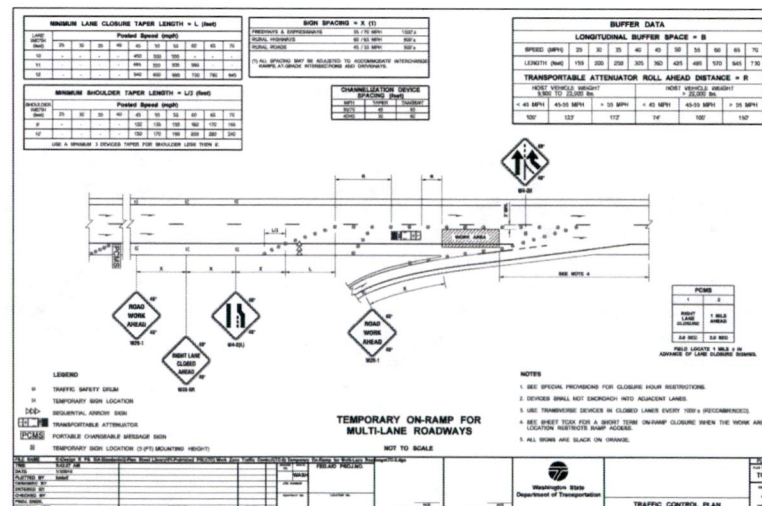
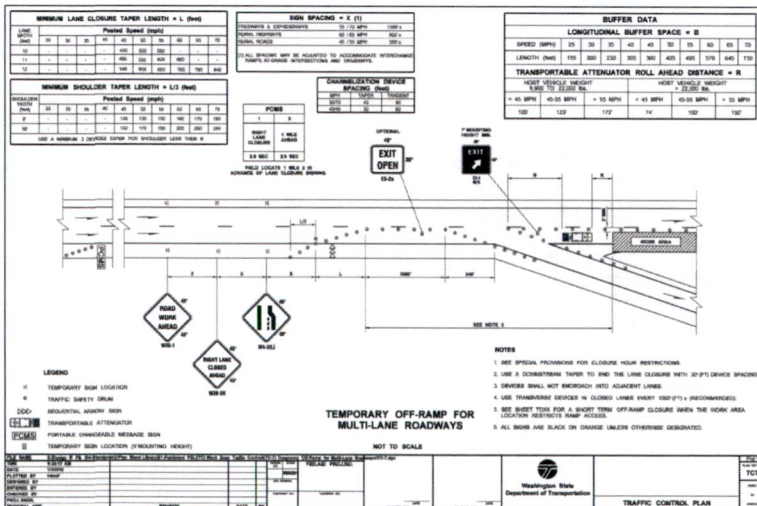
GENERAL TRAFFIC CONTROL NOTES

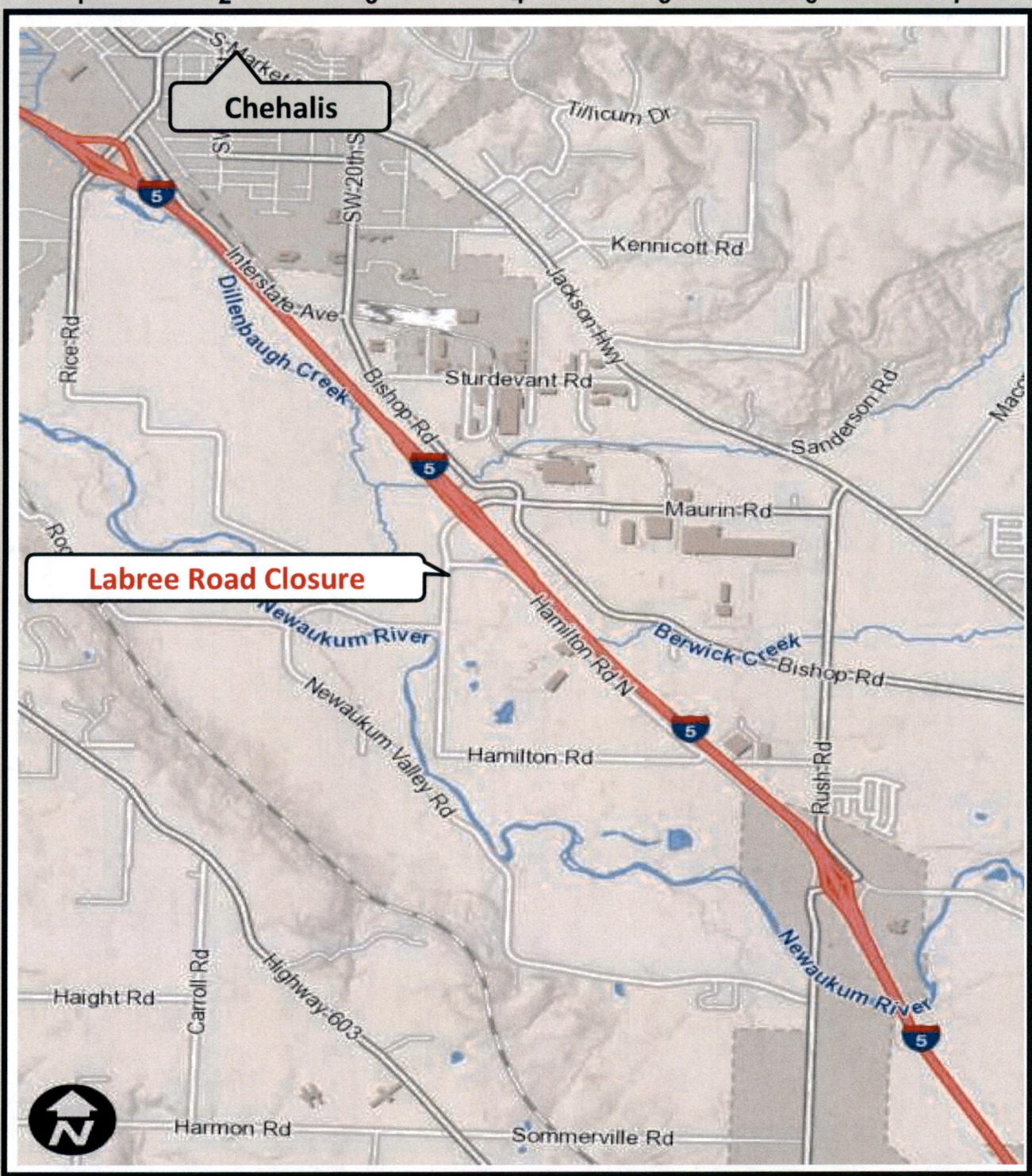
1. CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT TRAFFIC CONTROL AND CLOSURE PLAN FOR LABREE ROAD CLOSURE PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION COMMENCING.
2. APPROPRIATE METHODS OF PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC CONTROL, INCLUDING FLAGGERS, SHALL BE EMPLOYED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO THE EXTENT DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AND AS REQUIRED BY THE APPLICABLE AGENCY TO PROTECT WORKERS OR THIRD PARTIES.
3. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE ACCESS FOR SERVICES INCLUDING MAIL DELIVERY, TRASH PICKUP, SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION, BUSINESS DELIVERIES(PICKUPS) AND ANY SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE LOCAL RESIDENCE(S) WITHIN THE WORK AREA. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH RESIDENTS / BUSINESS TO INSURE ALL DELIVERIES AND GARBAGE PICK-UP IS MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF CONSTRUCTION.
4. SEE ALSO SPECIAL PROVISIONS, INCLUDING WSDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATION SECTION 1-27.32(1).
5. LABREE RD SHALL BE OPEN TO BOTH LOCAL AND THRU TRAFFIC UPON COMPLETION OF ROADWAY PAVING AND (TEMPORARY) STRIPING.


