WHEREAS, publication to solicit for fiber optics providers and installers is needed to contract with a professional fiber optics provider and installer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Information Services Director is instructed to prepare a request for proposals (RFP), evaluate responses and purchase said products and services; and the BOCC Clerk of Board is instructed to proceed with all appropriate and necessary notifications to advertise for said purpose; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proposals must be submitted online through the County's procurement portal, OpenGov, which can be accessed via the project site listed on the advertisement. Proposals are due by 5 p.m. August 29, 2025.
