AUTHORIZING FREE DISPOSAL OF FLOOD DAMAGED
DEBRIS RESULTING FROM DECEMBER 2025 FLOOD

Resolution No. 010-25

WHEREAS, THE LEWIS County Board of County Commissioners passed Resolution ----- on December 9, 2025, for a Declaration of Emergency due to conditions beginning on December 8, 2025, and continuing through the week created by a winter storm with atmospheric river precipitation, high winds and flooded lands in Lewis County; and

WHEREAS, the Lewis County Solid Waste Utility and Lewis County Emergency Management have developed procedures by which affected citizens can obtain and redeem vouchers for free disposal of flood damaged debris; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that free disposal of flood-damaged debris only, upon presentation of a voucher, is authorized at the Central Transfer Station, Centralia, and the East Lewis County Transfer Station, Morton, December 11, 2025, through December 31, 2025, in accordance with rules approved by the Disposal District Commissioners.
