**WHEREAS**, the Lewis County Board of County Commissioners has reviewed a proposed collective bargaining agreement between Lewis County, the Lewis County Prosecuting Attorney, and the Association of Lewis County Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys; and

**WHEREAS**, the agreement establishes wages, hours, and working conditions for the period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2028, and it appears to be in the best interest of Lewis County and the public to approve the agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the collective bargaining agreement between Lewis County, the Lewis County Prosecuting Attorney, and the Association of Lewis County Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys, effective January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2028, attached hereto, and authorizes the Chair to sign the agreement on behalf of the Board.
