PROJECT: Landslide repair and road stabilization of Rosebrook Rd between Milepost 0.49 and 0.69. Repair work includes pressure grouted soil anchors on 13 existing soldier piles to stabilize the roadway, six (6) new piles extending the wall to the northwest, replacing of the guardrail and road resurfacing.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located in Section 20, Township 13N, Range 01W within the shoreline jurisdiction of the Newaukum River. Lewis County's 2021 Shoreline Master Program designates this area of the Newaukum River as Shoreline Rural Conservancy.

PROCESS: A Notice of Application will be published in the County's Newspaper of Record and will initiate a 30-day public comment period in which interested persons may submit written comments. Once the comment period has ended, the decision will be issued. The decision is appealable to the State Shoreline Hearings Board under Lewis County Shoreline Master Program Section 7.05.05A. Only the applicant and persons submitting written comments within the comment period may appeal the decision to the State Shoreline Hearings Board.
