Road Access, Easement Violations & Legal Barriers

Good morning. My name is Doug Clyde, and I am a member of Lewis County for Safe Technology.

Before I address access to the proposed site, I would like to comment as a taxpaying citizen who loves living in Lewis County. The County has not been helpful in providing our group with timely information or addressing our concerns as residents who will be hurt by this project.

Twenty out of 21 landowners and homeowners have voted "NO" to this project. Big business should not overrule our vote when the negative impacts on our neighborhood are clear and they have not proven that they even considered other alternative, less harmful locations.

Our "NO" vote is clear on the critical issue regarding access to the proposed tower site that I will now address.

The applicant intends to access the site using Skyview Drive. However, Skyview Drive is not a public road. It is a private residential easement established in 1982 and governed by a Road Maintenance Agreement executed by the property owners.

Under that agreement, the easement is limited to the existing gravel roadway and to residential use by property owners and their guests. Construction and operation of a commercial telecommunications tower would fundamentally change that use. The project would require heavy construction equipment, contractors, technicians, fuel deliveries, and ongoing commercial traffic.

The applicant has also proposed road widening and improvements to meet fire access standards. But the easement as I understand it fixes the width and location of the road. Any widening or alteration requires the express consent of all affected property owners, and that consent has not been given.

In fact, property owners have formally submitted a Notice of Non-Consent, stating they do not consent to widening the road or allowing non-residential use associated with the tower.

For this reason alone, the application should be denied. There are of course other reasons as well, and others in the group will speak to those reasons.
