3. **VERIFICATION OF QUORUM:** A quorum was present with eight (8) of the ten members in attendance.
4. **PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:** November 10, 2021 meeting minutes approved by motion. Motioned by Peppy Elizaga and seconded by Bob Taylor. Motion Carried.
5. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** Don Bradshaw, Citizen/Winlock asked to speak. He thanked the group for the opportunity to serve on the committee but due to health issues he needs to resign.
6. **SWAC MEMBERS:** Member participation requirements and resignations.
  - Don Bradshaw indicated to Rocky that he was going to resign when Rocky called and checked in with him.
  - Jerry Lord, councilman for City of Chehalis and SWAC member, while attending the EAC meeting in November, communicated verbally with Rocky Lyon and Teri Lopez; that he did not have time to attend SWAC meeting which is why he had not attended any in 2021.
    - Rocky sent an email to Jerry asking for a formal resignation and did not receive a reply.
    - Mayor Dawes, City of Chehalis, was also notified. He was not aware that Jerry Lord had not attended the required meetings. He recognized the need to follow the SWAC by-laws regarding attendance. He will pass along the need for a new representative to the incoming mayor.
    - It was decided by the SWAC committee to accept his verbal communication as his resignation.
  - By-laws require at a minimum 9 members. SWAC and Solid Waste Staff will be working to find a new member.

- SWAC – Terry Harris, Chair – No new information.
- LeMay/Waste Connections – Tom Rupert, District Manager
  - Starting the pre-application process to open a composting facility
  - 180,000 tons per year – similar to Silver Springs
  - Would like to break ground by end of Q1 2022 and be accepting materials by end of year
  - Will be located at the Transalta mine site
- Department of Ecology – Olivia Carros – No new information.
  - Plastic Bag Ban Presentation by Shannon Jones, Department of Ecology
    - Presentation emailed to SWAC members for future reference
- Code Enforcement – Bill Teitzel – No new information.
- Lewis County Solid Waste – Utility Staff – Rocky Lyon, SW Manager
  - Community Recycling Events – Lewis County Community Recycling Events for the Fall
    - Included in the meeting packets was a one page summary of the Fall Events to date.
    - Lewis County Community Recycling Events for 2022 planning underway – letters have been sent to the cities
  - Community Litter Report – In October, the Litter program coordinator cleaned up 12 illegal dumpsites, removing 4,520 pounds of garbage, 20 tires, 4 semi-truck tires and 1 freezer. In addition, 42 volunteers spent 504 hours picking up 48 bags of litter. Volunteer groups included the Centralia Clean Team, the Kim Ashmore Family, the Karen and Richard Noto Family, Centralia Public Works and Centralia Boy Scout Troop #300. Under the SB5040 grant to clean freeway onramps and highway intersections, members of the Packwood/Randle communities picked up 8 bags of litter, 3 bulky items and 1 semi-truck tire.
  - Tonnage Report as presented at SWDD - Total tonnage for October was 7,501, which was 4% lower than the previous year. Customer count for October was 11,739, which is 8% lower than the previous year.
  - Budget for 2022 approved by SWDD on 11/22/21
  - Bob Taylor, SWAC Co-Chair inquired about Transfer station staffing. Rocky responded by stating that, Solid Waste is fully staffed. The two newest operators are completing necessary training. Rocky completed 6 month probation on 12/1/21 and Teri will complete on 12/16/21. New accountant is starting on her 2<sup>nd</sup> month.
  - Tipping Floor Office – Done. Power to portable office disconnected by Facilities and Pacific Mobile contacted about removal.
