### First Half Property Tax Deadline Approaching – April 30

The Lewis County Treasurer's Office is reminding property owners that first half property tax payments are due on **Thursday, April 30**.

Taxpayers who choose to mail their payments through the United States Postal Service (USPS) are strongly encouraged to ensure that their payment envelope receives an official postmark dated **on or before April 30**. Payments received without a valid or timely postmark may be considered late.

Late payments are subject to additional **interest and penalties as required by Washington State law**. The Treasurer's Office has no authority to waive these charges when payments are not postmarked by the due date.

To avoid delays or penalties, taxpayers may wish to:

- Mail payments early to ensure timely processing
- Request a hand-cancelled postmark at the post office
- Consider alternative payment methods, if available

The Lewis County Treasurer's Office appreciates the public's attention to this important deadline and encourages taxpayers to plan accordingly.
