ALL THROUGH TRAFFIC

RESOLUTION NO. 26-116

WHEREAS, RCW 47.48.010 gives authority to the county legislative authority to close roads for a period of time; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Puget Sound & Pacific Railroad to make repairs to the railroad crossing on Foron Road at milepost 0.80; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to close Foron Road between Harrison Avenue and Kuper Road to all through traffic during the period of such project work; and

WHEREAS, Foron Road will remain open for local access from either end up to but not beyond the point of closure and other county roads are available for detour.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to RCW 47.48.010 and .020, beginning at 7 a.m. April 13, 2026, and ending by 5 p.m. April 27, 2026, Foron Road between Harrison Avenue and Kuper Road, shall be closed to all through traffic.

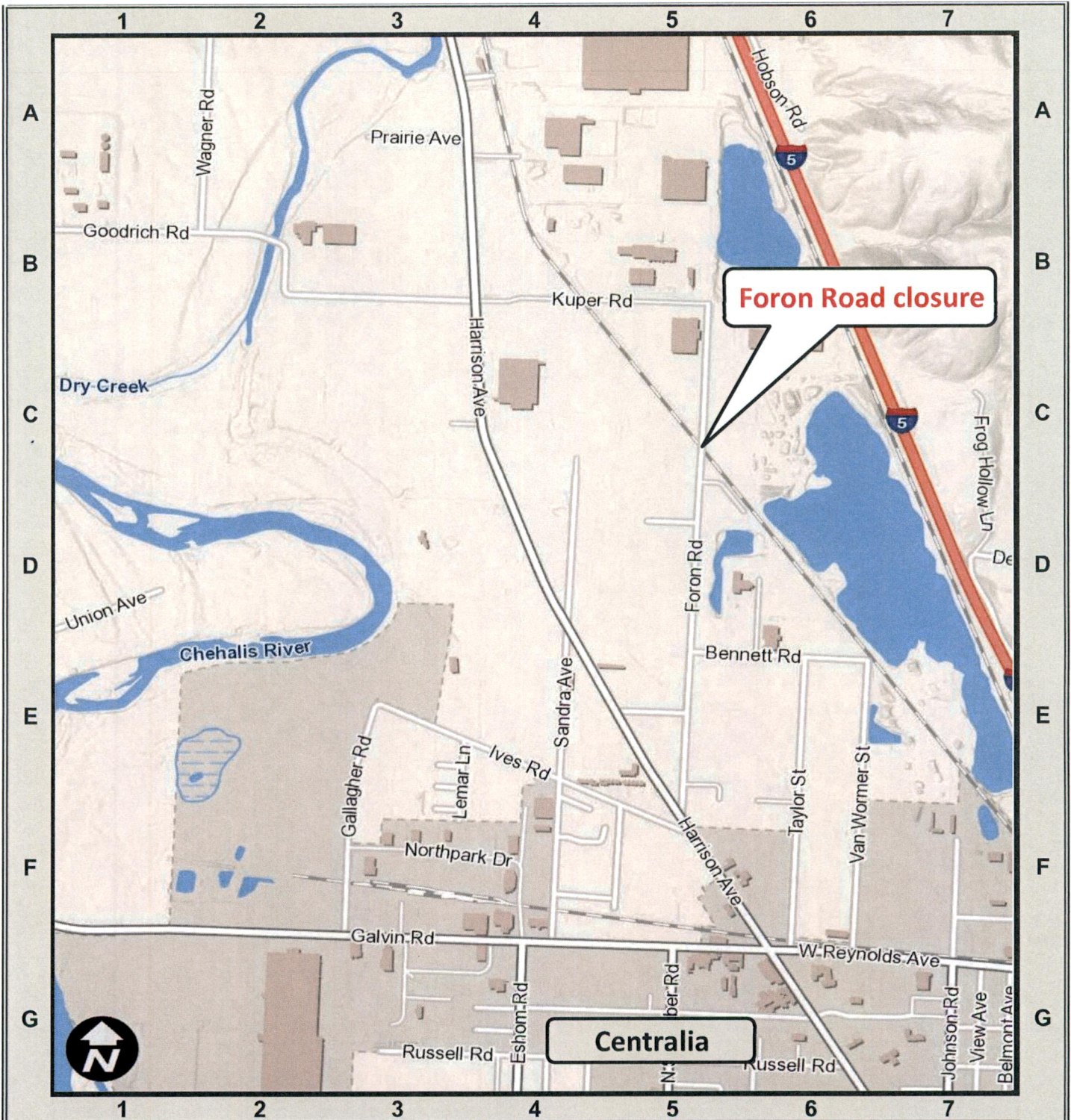

NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners, Lewis County, Washington, has approved the temporary closure of Foron Road Railroad Crossing at Milepost 0.80 to all through traffic for railroad maintenance. During the closure the road will remain open to local access from either end up to but not beyond the points of closure and other county roads are available for detour. Pursuant to RCW 47.48.010 and .020, effective 7:00 a.m. Monday, April 13th, 2026, and ending 5:00 p.m. Monday, April 27th, 2026, or sooner, that Foron Road described above, shall be closed to all through traffic.

It is the policy of Lewis County that no person shall, on the basis of race, color, or national origin, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise discriminated against under any of its Federally funded programs and activities. Lewis County was notified on April 9th, 2026, of the planned closure of Foron Road at MP 0.80 by Puget Sound & Pacific Railroad for crossing repairs. It will be necessary to close Foron Road to all through traffic during this period. Foron Road will remain open for local access from either end up to but not beyond the point of closure. This resolution would, pursuant to RCW 47.48.010 and .020, close Foron Road to all through traffic between Harrison Avenue to the south and the end of Kuper Rd to the north. The Closure will begin at 7:00 a.m., April 13th, 2026, and end at 5:00 p.m., April 27, 2026.
