**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that** Lewis County has received a Type II Administrative Application and a SEPA Checklist from **Stephen Robinson** for the following development proposal:

Other known permits required include, but are not limited to building, septic, stormwater and public water supply.

An administrative decision on the Type II application (per Lewis County Code (LCC) 17.05) will be made after the expiration of the comment period. The final decision of the Type II application may be appealed in accordance with the Lewis County Code Chapter 2.25. The SEPA determination will be issued at that same time as the administrative decision for the Type II application without an additional comment period. The SEPA determination may be appealed in accordance with LCC 17.110.130.
