Once the comment period has ended, the decision will be issued. The decision is appealable to the State Shoreline Hearings Board under Lewis County Shoreline Master Program Section 7.05.05A. Only the applicant and persons submitting written comments within the comment period may appeal the decision to the State Shoreline Hearings Board.
