May 20, 2026

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 11:31 am by Commissioner Faupell. The April 14, 2026 minutes were approved as written.

Secretarial Report: Linda Bailey

The BOCC is starting their budget process. They would like confirmation the hours and wage of the Civil Service Secretary will remain the same in 2027. Employee Status Report and Administrative Report: Kevin Engelbertson

Corrections Deputy Andrew R. Corey was promoted to Corrections Sergeant effective May 2, 2026.

Corrections Deputy Kevin Calvillo-Gonzalez received probationary appointment effective June 16, 2026.

Deputy Sheriff Trainee Isabella Holmes received probationary appointment effective May 1, 2026.

Corrections Bureau:

Corrections Deputy Dalton Morris is currently at the Corrections Academy in Burien and is scheduled to graduate on June 18, 2026.

Corrections Deputies Tristan Cross and Parker Chambers are at the Corrections Academy in Vancouver and are scheduled to graduate on July 15, 2026.

After the promotion of Sergeant Corey and the hire of Corrections Deputy Calvillo-Gonzalez, we will have one corrections lieutenant vacancy, one sergeant vacancy, and three corrections deputy vacancies. We currently have two corrections deputy applicants in the background process and have additional interviews scheduled this week.

Operations Bureau:

Both deputies have returned from Critical Incident Leave.

Deputy Sheriff Trainee Isabella Holmes completed her FTO Training and went to Probationary Deputy status effective May 1, 2026.

Deputy Sheriff Trainee Austin Gilbert is proceeding well in his FTO training.

After Deputy Ferguson's retirement on June 1, 2026, we have one sergeant, three deputy and two detective positions open. We have two deputy applicants in the background process. We have three entry-level deputy interviews scheduled for today and tomorrow.

Services Bureau:

With the upcoming vacancies, at the next meeting we would like to discuss posting for the Support Technician 1 position.
