**WHEREAS**, Lewis County is working to enhance safety, user experience and operational efficiency at the Southwest Washington Fairgrounds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Friendlyville area has long been an under-utilized portion of the fairgrounds due to difficult terrain, limited accessibility and aging infrastructure. Uneven ground, loose gravel and seasonal mud make the area challenging for exhibitors, youth participants, families and individuals with mobility limitations; and

**WHEREAS**, Lewis County is seeking a qualified contractor for its Friendlyville Improvements project (Project 31-2607b), which will include regrading the terrain, installing ADA-compliant pathways and restructuring the fair gates to improve flow; and

**WHEREAS**, proposals must be submitted electronically through OpenGov (<https://procurement.opengov.com/portal/lewiscountywa>) and are due by 2 p.m. June 30, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, a mandatory pre-bid walk will take place at 1 p.m. June 15, 2026, at the Fair Office at the Southwest Washington Fairgrounds, and the deadline for proposal questions is 5 p.m. June 22, 2026.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Lewis County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) hereby issues a call for bids for the Friendlyville Improvements project. Bids must be submitted online through the County's procurement portal, OpenGov (<https://procurement.opengov.com/portal/lewiscountywa>) no later than 2 p.m. June 30, 2026; and

Bids submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

A mandatory pre-bid walk will take place at 1 p.m. June 15, 2026, at the Fair Office at the Southwest Washington Fairgrounds, and the deadline for proposal questions is 5 p.m. June 22, 2026.

Lewis County will open the sealed bids and publicly read them aloud at or after 2 p.m. June 30, 2026, in the Commissioners' Hearing Room, Lewis County Historic Courthouse, 351 NW North Street, Chehalis, Washington.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory contract bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to Lewis County Capital Fund 3010. This bid proposal deposit is to be submitted through the OpenGov portal only (do not mail or hand deliver).

All Contractor questions and Lewis County clarifying answers will be posted on the OpenGov website. Plan or specification changes shall be accomplished through official project addendums on OpenGov. Both questions/answers and addenda shall be posted without additional newspaper publication.
