PROJECT: Creation of a graveled access road and pad for future maintenance of the Galvin Road Bridge. The work will include approximately 378 cubic yards of excavation and 378 cubic yards of fill material for the construction of the access and 1,805 square foot heavy equipment pad within the County right-of-way.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located in Section 02, Township 14N, Range 03W within the shoreline jurisdiction of the Chehalis River. Lewis County's 2021 Shoreline Master Program designates this area of the Chehalis River as Shoreline Rural Conservancy.

PROCESS: A Notice of Application will be published in the County's Newspaper of Record and will initiate a 30-day public comment period in which interested persons may submit written comments. Once the comment period has ended, the decision will be issued. The decision is appealable to the State Shoreline Hearings Board under Lewis County Shoreline Master Program Section 7.05.05A. Only the applicant and persons submitting written comments within the comment period may appeal the decision to the State Shoreline Hearings Board.

SEPA: Lewis County is Lead Agency for this proposal; A Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) was issued on June 23, 2026, and comments will be received until July 23, 2026.
