THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BISHOP ROAD TO
ALL THROUGH TRAFFIC

RESOLUTION NO. 26-193

WHEREAS, RCW 47.48.010 gives authority to the county legislative authority to close roads for a period of time; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Lewis County to replace a barrier culvert with a fish passable structure on Bishop Road crossing Berwick Creek; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to close Bishop Road from MP 2.65 to MP 3.03 to all through traffic during the period of such work; and

WHEREAS, Bishop Road will remain open for local access from either end up to but not beyond the point of closure at MP 2.839, and other county roads are available for detour.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to RCW 47.48.010 and .020, beginning July 13, 2026, and ending October 30, 2026, Bishop Road from MP 2.65 to MP 3.03, in Section 15, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, W.M., shall be closed to all through traffic.

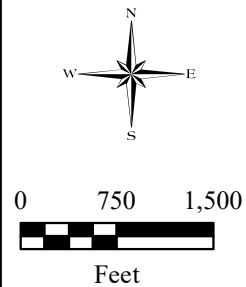
