PROJECT: Bridge scour repair at the Wildwood Road crossing of the Chehalis River at MP 10.14. Project includes riprap protection for the piers and bridge abutments utilizing isolation of work area from surface water, excavation of existing riprap and streambed material, new scour counter measures, and topping of project area with streambed material. Restoration of the area will also occur along with habitat improvement including large wooding material upstream and downstream, removal of invasive plants and restoring native riparian habitat.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located in Section 24, Township 12N, Range 04W within the shoreline jurisdiction of the Chehalis River. Lewis County's 2021 Shoreline Master Program designates this area of the Chehalis as Shoreline Rural Conservancy.

PUBLIC HEARING: An open record hearing will be scheduled before the Lewis County Hearing Examiner after comments have been reviewed and after the conclusion of the public 30-day shoreline notice of application comment period. The shoreline hearing will be scheduled in a virtual only format through the Zoom meeting platform. The scheduled public hearing date is also dependent on the applications ahead of this one, which are currently under review.

A Notice of Public Hearing for this shoreline application will be issued after the comment period is complete and at least 30 days prior to any scheduled Public Hearing date. The notice will establish the date, time and Zoom log-in information of this virtual public hearing. Persons on the notice of application mailing list will be sent a public hearing notice, as will any other persons that provide written comments during the public 30-day notice of application comment period.

SEPA: Lewis County is Lead Agency for this proposal, a DNS will be issued concurrently with the Shoreline notice.
