INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL ADMINISTRATION

This agreement, made and entered into this <u>25th</u> day of <u>February</u>, 1993 by and between Solid Waste Disposal District No. 1 of Lewis County, a quasi-municipal corporation, hereafter referred to as "District" and Lewis County, a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the state of Washington, hereafter referred to as "County",

WITNESSETH:

Whereas, Counties and Solid Waste Disposal Districts each have authority to provide for disposal of solid wastes and are authorized under provision of Chapter 39.34 RCW and RCW 39.34.080 to contract with one another for the provision of any governmental service, activity or undertaking which each public agency entering into the agreement is authorized by law to perform, and

Whereas, the parties deem it desirable for the County to provide administrative and support services for the District,

IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The District shall be responsible for establishing tipping fee rates at the transfer station facilities. These fees as established shall be sufficient to pay the following costs and expenses:
 - Transport and disposal of solid waste.
 - b. Rent to county for transfer station
 - c. Operational costs of the transfer station.
 - d. Reserves for unforseen emergencies and depreciation and replacement of fixed assets.
 - Reserve for Centralia Landfill Closure.
 - f. Host fee to City of Centralia

- g. Planning, Program Implementation, and Administration for county wide solid waste activities, including funds for solid waste monitoring and enforcement programs.
- h. Partial subsidy for drop box operations.
- 2. The district shall be responsible for the collection of revenues associated with solid waste disposal due as tipping fees.
- 3. The district shall pay invoices presented by the export contractor for the transfer and disposal of solid waste received at county or district transfer stations.
- 4. The district shall pay to the county the monthly rental fees for the new transfer station located at Centralia Landfill Site. Said monthly payments shall be made to Lewis County General Government.
- 7. The district shall pay the costs associated with the operation of the transfer station and associated facilities by the Lewis County Public Services Department. The county will present a bill monthly to the district for services rendered.
- 6. All staff and program management responsibilities shall be performed by Lewis County through its Public Services Department on behalf of the district. The district shall pay these costs upon presentation of monthly invoices by Lewis County through its Department of Public Services.
- 7. This agreement shall become effective upon signature by all parties hereto and upon its filing with the county auditor and the secretary of state. It may be terminated at any time during the term on 30 days notice from one party to the other. The base term of the agreement shall be five years from the date of signing and may be renewed at the discretion of the parties.
