ESTABLISHMENT OF 2021 COUNTY ROAD
CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS BY COUNTY FORCES

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 36.77.070 any construction performed by County Forces where the estimated cost of the work exceeds \$10,000 must be published in one issue of a newspaper of general circulation in the county prior to construction; and

WHEREAS, the Lewis County 2021-2026 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program and 2021 Annual Construction Program adopted via Resolution 20-415 on November 16, 2020, lists portions of 2021 construction projects to be constructed by County Forces.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the County Forces project funds, listed in Exhibit A, are to be expended in the calendar year 2021, for the estimated costs shown and are hereby to be published in compliance with RCW 36.77.070. Costs shown do not include engineering, right of way expenses, or County Forces projects less than \$10,000 (ten thousand dollars).

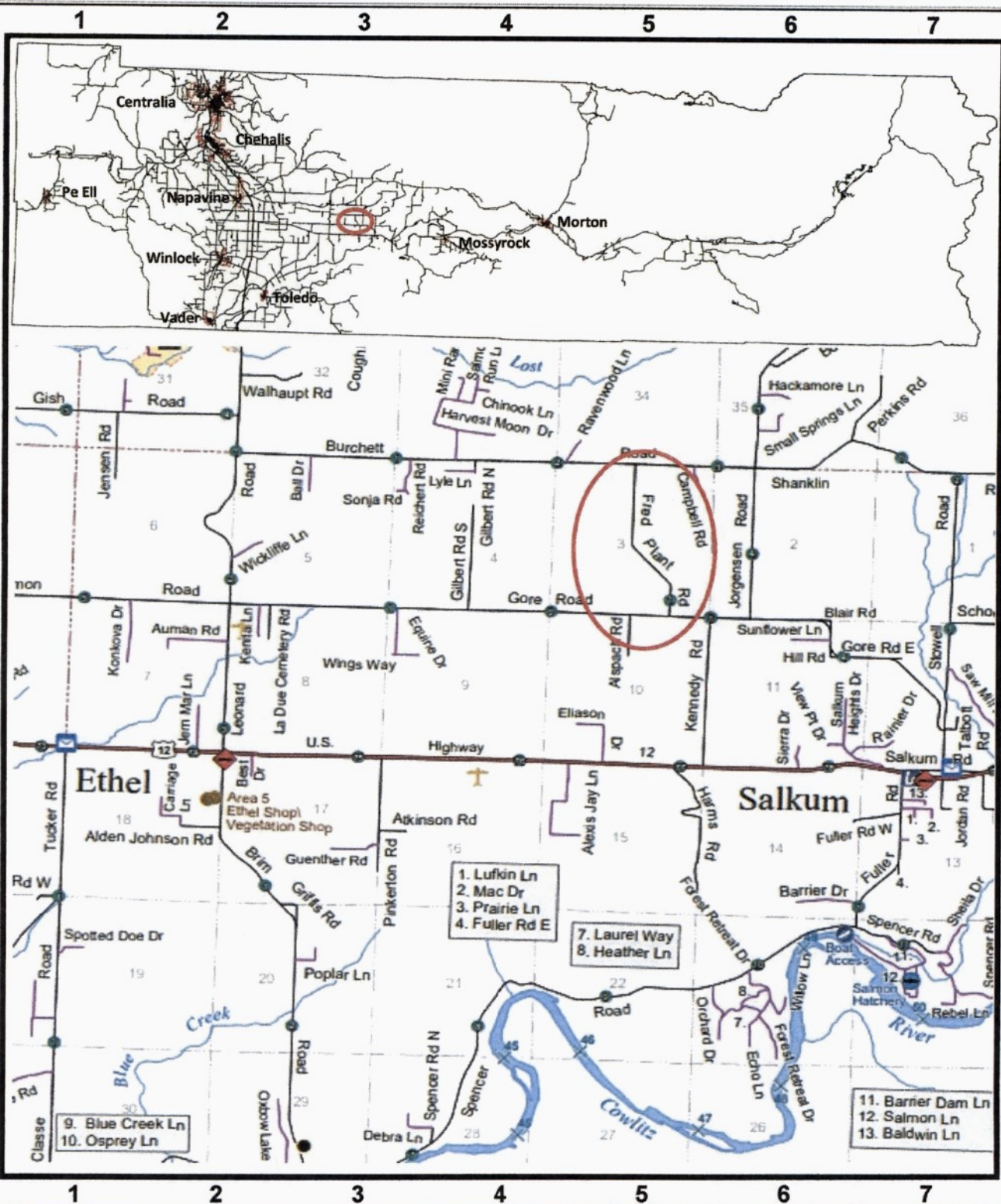

WAC 136-18-030**Authorization of construction by county forces projects.**

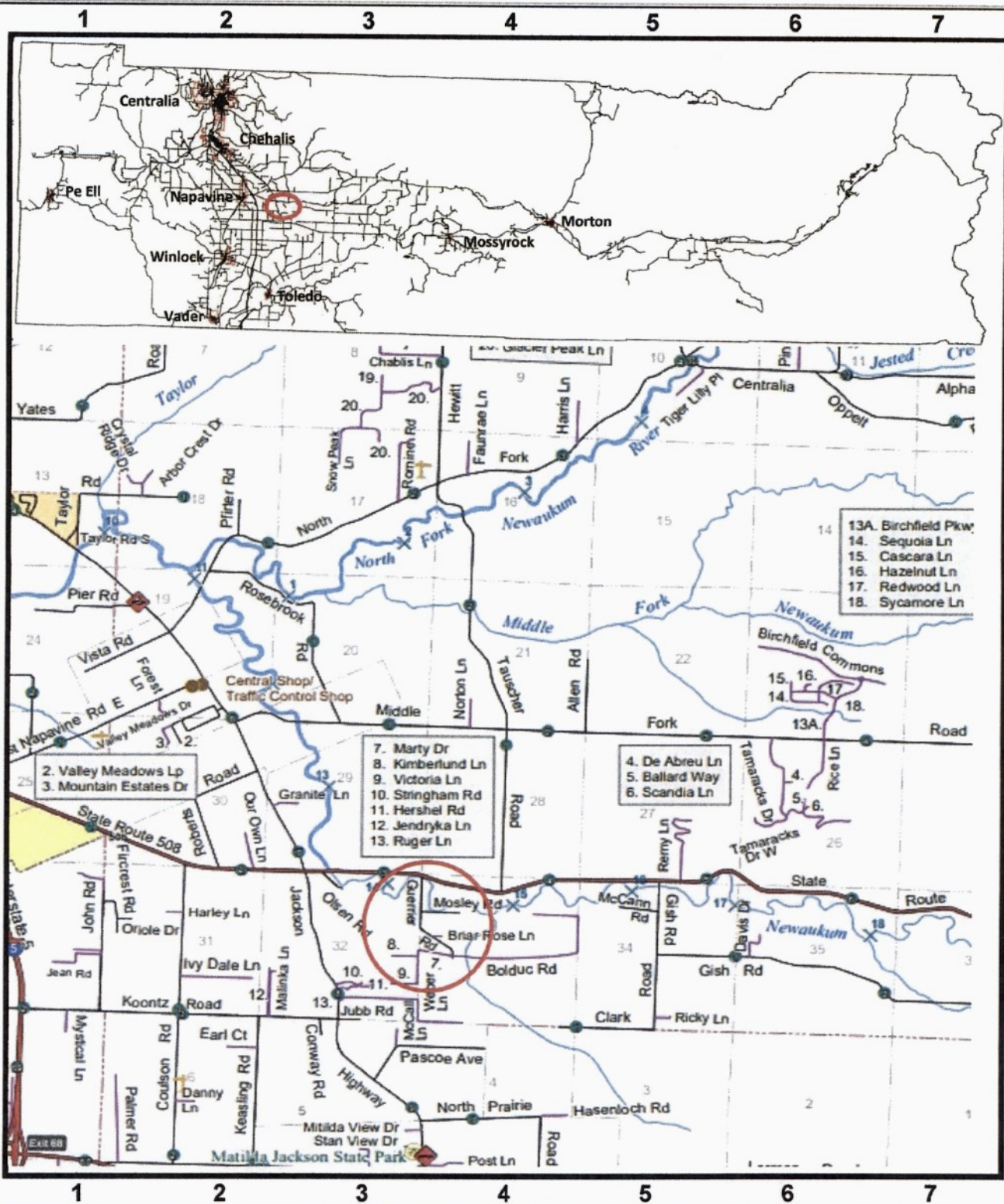
Every proposed construction by county forces road project shall be a part of the county's annual construction program as defined in RCW 36.81.130 and WAC 136-16-020. Additions to the program, and/or substitutions in the program, may be made by unanimous action of the county legislative authority at any time as provided in RCW 36.81.130. No construction work shall be done on any project until it has been authorized by resolution of said authority. The resolution shall include:

- (1) A brief description of the project;
- (2) A vicinity map showing the location of the project and its limits, provided that in lieu of individual vicinity maps, a single vicinity map showing the location of all projects may be included with the resolution adopting the annual program;
- (3) Identification of the project in terms of the officially adopted annual program;
- (4) The county engineer's estimate of construction costs prepared pursuant to the completion of such preliminary engineering; and
- (5) Construction plans as shall be necessary and sufficient.

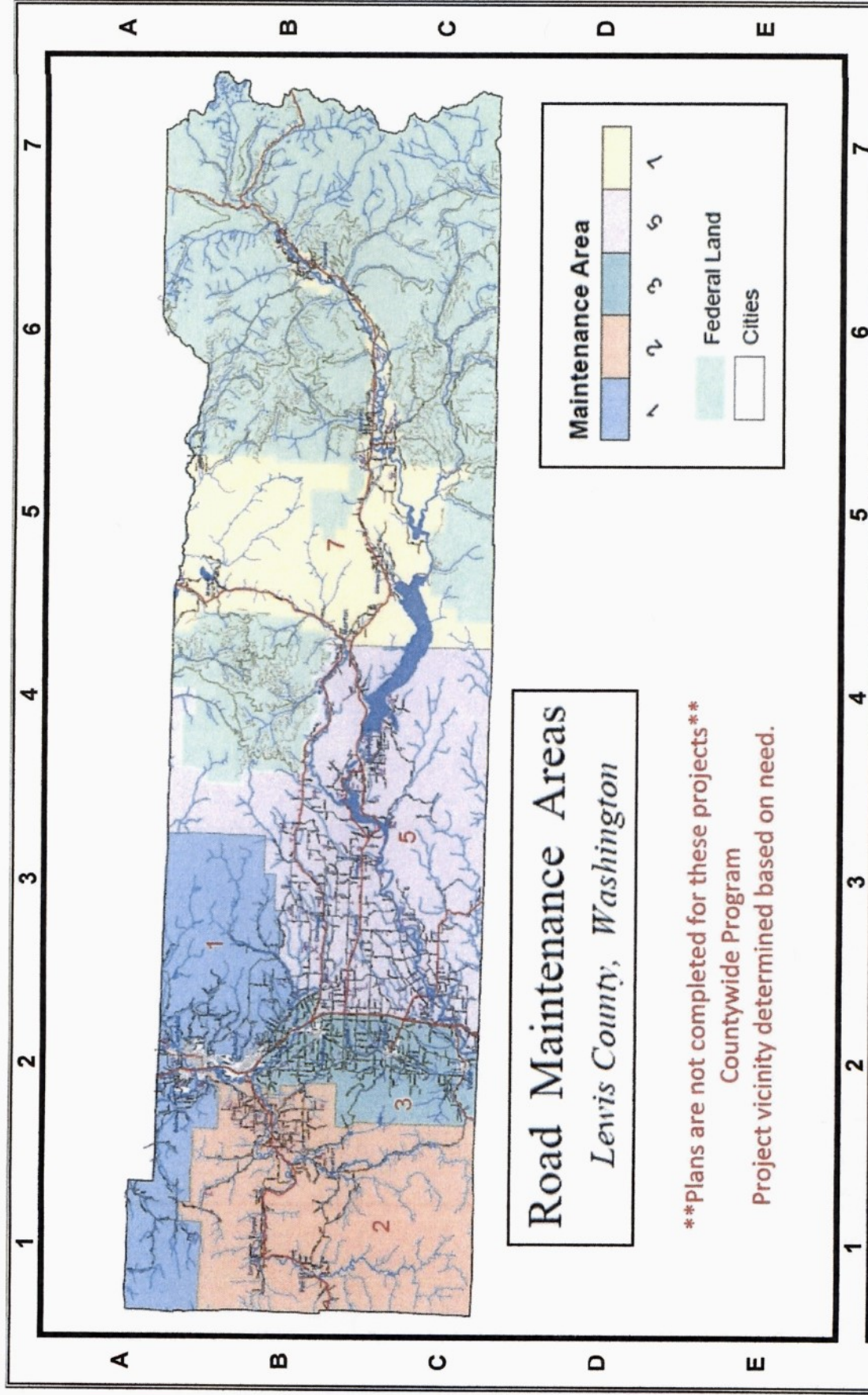

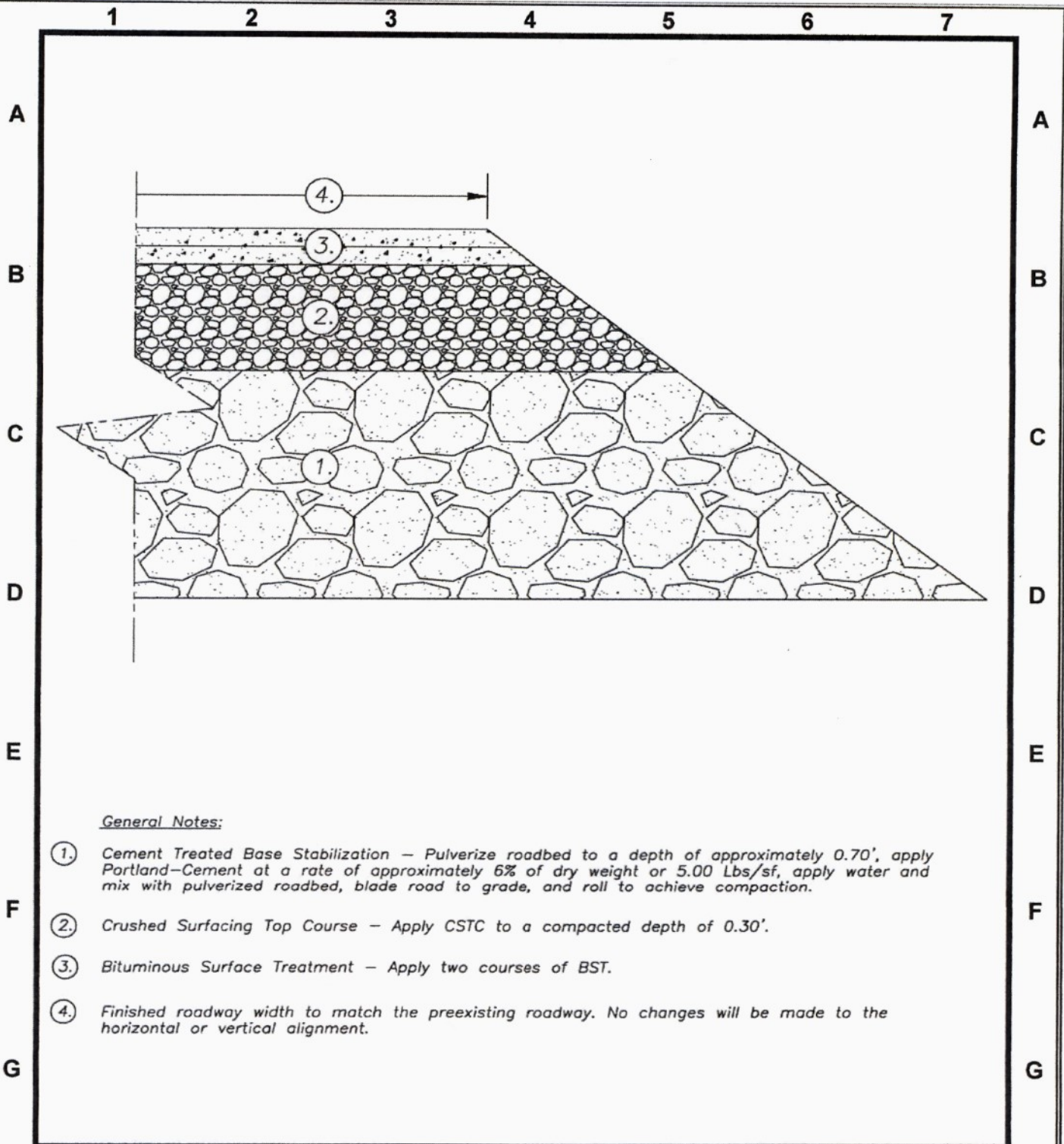

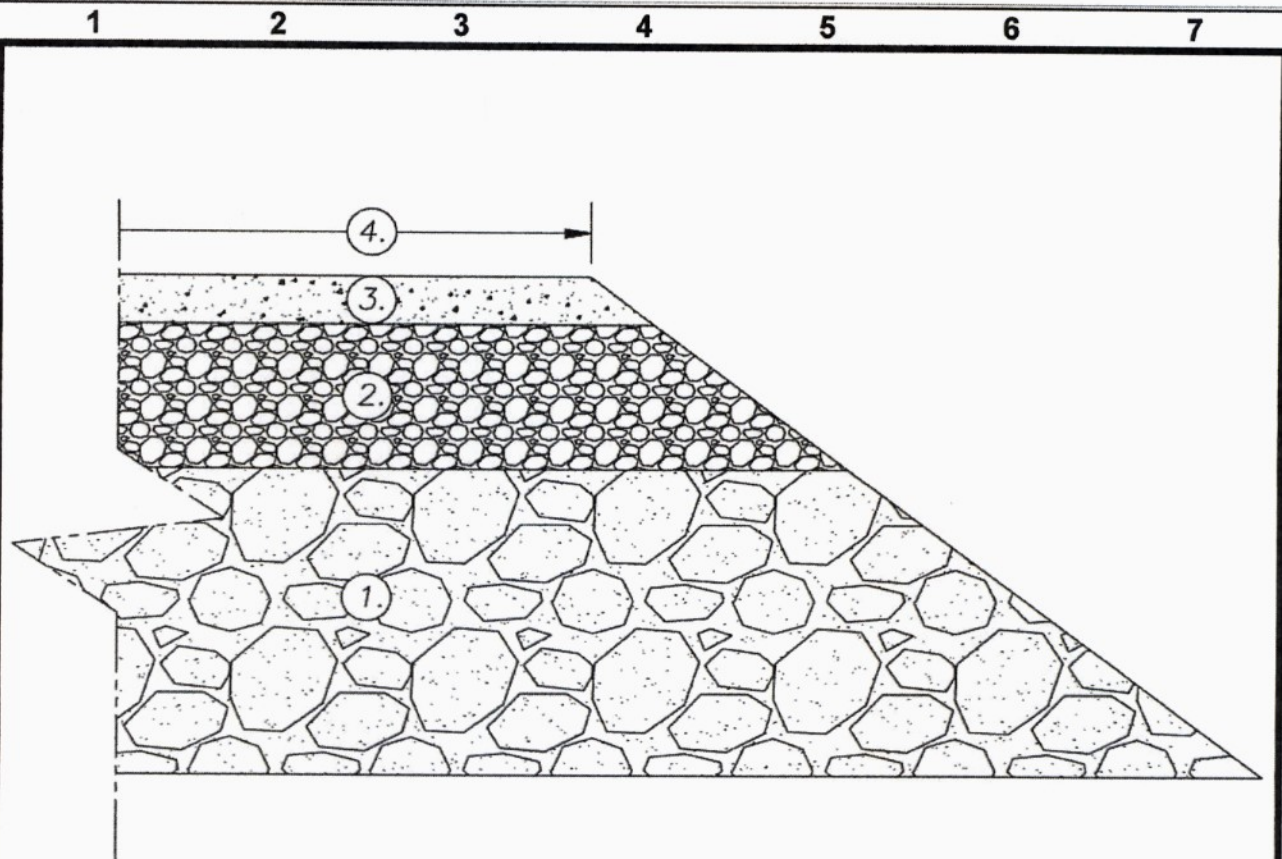

General Notes:

- ①. Cement Treated Base Stabilization – Pulverize roadbed to a depth of approximately 0.70', apply Portland-Cement at a rate of approximately 6% of dry weight or 5.00 Lbs/sf, apply water and mix with pulverized roadbed, blade road to grade, and roll to achieve compaction.
- ②. Crushed Surfacing Top Course – Apply CSTC to a compacted depth of 0.30'.
- ③. Hot Mix Asphalt – One Course 0.20' HMA
- ④. Finished roadway width to match the preexisting roadway. No changes will be made to the horizontal or vertical alignment.
