Resolution 21-369: Approval of warrants/claims against the various county departments.

Chief accountant Grace Jimenez, representing the Auditor's Office, said warrants 847,352 through 847,626 and direct disbursements numbered 3891, 3893 through 3897, 3909, 3916 through 3929, 3937, 3947 through 3950, 3973, 4016, 4019, 4002 through 4005, 4011 and 4024 through 4025 were issued in

October for payments against the county totaling \$3,583,563.10. She said payroll / tax deposit warrants numbered 795,860 through 795,864 and Automatic Deposits numbered 31,532 through 32,120 also were approved for payments against the county totaling \$1,121,428.51. Grace noted a skip in sequence for warrants 847,330 - 847,351, which were issued on behalf of Special Purpose Districts.
