Project Selection Criteria

- Pavement Rating System (1-10 possible points)
 - Data maintained on all County roads.
- Maintenance Offset (1-5 possible points)
 - Estimated project benefit offsetting on-going maintenance expense.
- Traffic Counts (1-10 possible points)
 - Average Daily Traffic a measure of probable use and congestion.
- Support by Other Plans (1-5 possible points)
 - Does the project have connection to other state, federal or local plans?
- Supplemental Funding (1-10 possible points)
 - Does the project qualify for supplemental state or federal funding?
- Geographic Equity (1-5 possible points)
 - Is the project located to provide geographic equity within the County?

Project Selection

TIP Evaluation Process:

- Review previous TIP
- Selection criteria applied to all new candidate project (existing project scores reanalyzed every 3 years)
- Analyze project feasibility
- Adjust projects based on individual merits and budget constraints

TIP Finalization:

- Presentation of preliminary TIP to communities and decision makers
- Adjust the TIP based on public response and budgeting constraints
- Proposal submitted to the Board of County Commissioners for a Public Hearing action in November of each year
