#### **Housing In Lewis County**

- 70% of housing is single family residential
- Average sale price \$119,000 (2012) to \$397,000 (2022)
- 77% decrease in supply of homes for sale 2012-2022
- Median household income \$54,970 (2020)
- Renters 45% are paying more than 30% of their income on rent; 22% are paying more than 50% (2021)

#### **Housing Initiative - Objectives**

**Objective 1:** Continuously learn from the community about their expectations and needs for housing.

**Objective 2:** Ensure that everyone has night-by-night shelter and a path to stable and safe housing.

**Objective 3:** Provide affordable housing options at all income levels.

**Objective 4:** Increase rural housing density near existing essential services including schools, medical facilities, grocery stores and transit.

**Objective 5:** Provide public infrastructure improvements to growing rural town centers.

**Objective 6:** Encourage enhanced commercial services and employment opportunities within existing rural town centers.

**Objective 7:** Partner with cities to coordinate housing efforts across Lewis County.






#### **Rural Housing Alternatives - Research**

**Purpose** – Determine the range of housing types that could occur in LAMIRDs and RDD zones without needing municipal water, sewer or stormwater (where such services are not available) and without having a significant impact on fire, EMS or schools

- Identify housing that can use existing services without needing additional services not available in rural areas
- Results will be shared with Planning Commission (and other stakeholders)
- Used for Rural Housing Update 1 and 2



#### **Urban Growth**

- Governmental coordination
  - Napavine HAPI grant
  - City Zoning missing middle housing types
  - Improved mayor's meeting
  - Centralia "vision" work
  - Hopeful: Chehalis infill planning
  - Possible: regional planning?



#### **Urban Growth**

- Housing-Supportive Infrastructure
  - Packwood sewer (Public Works)
  - Bishop Rd water loop
  - Morton utilities expansion
  - Chehalis transit / shuttle
  - Low-income housing services (HB 1220)
  - Water banking (is both urban and rural)
  - Fire-district capacity (ditto)

- Future: Westlund/Enbody development


